We first met in 1973 when I was on my first pioneer mission – starting up a church center in Richmond, Virginia. He was on an IOWC (International One World Crusade) team that came through. True Father had sent out one pioneer to each state – and then he created several IOWC teams that traveled from the west to the east, stopping to give a boost to the new church centers.

I am sure that was Eric's first mission as well. That was 40 years ago. Eric served God and True Parents faithfully in America for 40 years. As his elder son, Shayne, shared at the Seong Hwa ceremony, "I never once heard my father express a word of complaint." That is an incredible testimony. Eric ultimately gave his life for God's providence in this nation.
