1) Jesus Teaches about Prayer

Jesus told us what we should do if we want God to help us.

Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

ASK AND RECEIVE






Jesus said that if we want to receive anything we have to ask for it. Have a bowl of cut fruit in front of the children. Don't offer it unless the children ask. Only give it to those who ask. Look at the pictures. We should always ask using the word please. What could you ask for right now?

SEEK AND FIND





Search

Find

Jesus also said that if you seek or search for something hard enough you will find it. Look at the picture. In a game of hide and seek you will find the person hiding, if you keep searching. Hide some objects in the room for the children to find. Examples: pencils, coins, plastic cups, balloons,

KNOCK AND OPEN





Jesus also said that if you knock on someone's door they will answer. Look at the picture. If you don't knock the person inside won't know you are there. If you really want something you have to make effort and God will help you. Today's story is about what happened when a girl asked God to help

2) A Good Day for Becky

* Becky doesn't want to go to the nursery, because of a new boy, called Mike, who spoils their games. She only want to play with her best friends. Becky's mother thinks he might not make trouble if she lets him play with her. 'She tells Becky to ask God to help, so that she can have a good time and to find a way to include Mike in her play. She does pray and the day goes very well. In fact, she asks her mother if she can invite the new boy to play sometimes in their home.

3) Questions about the story

- * Why didn't Becky want to go to the nursery that day? because Mike was unkind
- * Mother gave Becky an idea of what to do that day. What was her idea? *invite Mike to be part of their play*
- * What did Mother and Becky do before they left home? pray
- * Becky did invite Mike to play doll house with the girls. How do you think Mike felt about being included? *happy*
- * How did he act that day? kind, he shared the banana; he didn't tease the girls
- * Did the day go better for Becky than she had thought it would? yes, because they all played happily, and got along together
- * Do you think God helped Becky? yes
- * Why did God help? Becky asked for help

4) God Answers Prayers

Because Becky asked for help, God answered her prayer. When we pray God listens to us. If we want to help someone God will help. If we need help with something, God will help us. Jesus said that if we ask, God will answer our prayers because He loves us. What kind of things could you ask God for?

- If someone in your nursery spoils things for others, ask God to help
- Ask God to help you be a good friend to others
- Ask God to help you to be a good boy or girl and do as your parents say
- Ask God what you can do to help your mummy and daddy
- Pray that your brothers and sisters can care for each other


The afternoon hours hurried along and soon it was time to go home. Becky's mother came to the door. "Ready, Becky?" she asked.




