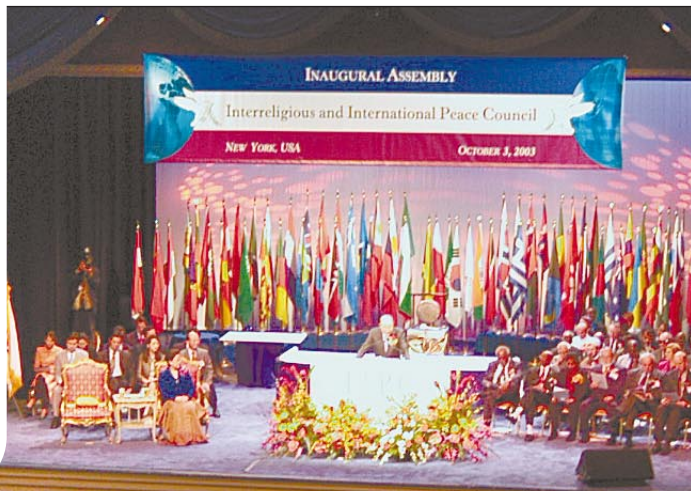
The Interreligious and International Peace Council (IIPC)," said H.E. Debbie H. Remengesau, First Lady of the Republic of Palau, "can improve existing methods and

FOUNDER’S DISCOURSE ON UNIFICATIONISM

Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon

This speech was given at the New Yorker Hotel, New York City, NY, USA, October 3, 2003.

Respected guests, over the past 50 years, as humanity has experienced many trials and wars, both locally and internationally, it has placed its trust in the United Nations as the only institution that could address these issues on a global scale. However, the world we live in today has reached a point where the United Nations, as it currently exists, cannot successfully address this enormous challenge. Likewise, although the United States has emerged as the world's lone superpower, it does not have the capacity to deal with the crises that we confront today. We must conclude that political, economic, and military power, by themselves, cannot meet the critical challenges of the day.

Today I would like to take this precious opportunity to speak on the topic "The New Elimination of Boundaries and World Peace" and convey to you Heaven's message for this age. Truly, this is a joyful, historic, and providential declaration before the hundreds of billions of human beings now living on earth and in the spirit world.

Today, on every level, boundaries cause division and conflict. If we can eliminate all the boundaries in this world, a world of peace would inevitably come about. We must recognize who owns those boundaries. Clearly, it is not God. It was the devil, Satan,

who first created boundaries. Wherever a boundary exists, there is always the devil and his cohorts. This is a result of the Human Fall, when the first human ancestors switched their lineage, and good and evil began to diverge from each other. When we look at the division between the East and the West, we see that different cultural spheres have led to antagonism at their boundaries and that the devil is encamped there. It was Satan, not God, who created boundaries, by digging all sorts of traps and enmeshing people in racial discrimination and evil cultures, histories, and traditions. God's desire is for a world of goodness and unity -- a world of oneness in which all humanity lives as one great family. Boundaries have no place in such a world. In a world without boundaries, there can be no enemies. The concept of "enemy" entails the existence of boundaries.

When we love our enemies and make oneness with them, the boundaries between us will collapse. That is why God's strategy and tactic has always been "Love your enemy." There can be no greater strategy for peace than this. Throughout history, this incredible fact has escaped humanity's understanding, and it has yet to be grasped even in modern times.

Today, I tell you clearly that God's strategy and tactic for human salvation is to love your enemy. You and the members of the Unification Church who have followed me until now are the representatives of history as well as of the current world who now know Heaven's incredible secret. Our responsibility now is to inherit this principle, put it into practice, and become a true human being. If you accomplish these things, you

are sure to become a key player in bringing about a world of peace.

Respected guests, when and where are boundaries formed? Boundaries first take shape within ourselves. They form in places where our hearts find something disagreeable, where our bodies find something disagreeable, where we find our own actions to be disagreeable, and where we find our own words to be disagreeable. When, in response to our five senses, our mind and body are in disharmony, boundaries of all sorts come into being. Please take a moment to consider all the different kinds of boundaries, both large and small, that fill our lives.

If you are determined to practice the maxims "Don't have enemies" and "Don't create boundaries," there may come a time when you will need to pluck out one of your own eyes. This is because it is possible to have two kinds of eyes. If you have an eye that says, "This is nice, and that is nice, too," and likes everything it sees, good and bad, then a huge boundary will form in that eye, separating how that eye sees the world from how God sees the world. The same is true with our hearing. On the one hand, we like listening to words of goodness and truth, while on the other, we also listen to the evil words of the world and conform ourselves to them. When we do this, we create boundaries in our ears.

When I initiated the Unification Church, I did not forbid our members from listening to popular songs even though many Christians banned such music. The issue is not whether the music is a popular or classical piece, but whether the person singing a particular song is able to digest its content correctly. Good and evil are not determined by genre. The question is whether singing a particular song eliminates an existing boundary or creates a new one. If a person is able to build a bridge of true love that is pleasing to God, then it does not matter what kind of song he sings, whether it is a popular song or even a song whose words are in some exotic language.

From this perspective, the fact that the boundaries found in your environment are the result of sensations received through your five senses as well as everything that has been passed down to you through the ladder of historical tradition means that it is not by your own choice that you find yourselves belonging to Satan's domain. In other words, if there were no boundaries in our lives, we could stand on God's side. Please remember that Satan is a king who has used every means possible to create boundaries in our lives, and that God is the King who hates boundaries more than anything else.

As you know, the Korean peninsula where I was born is still divided between North and South near the 38th Parallel. Those who like having this divi-

sion along the 38th Parallel are on Satan's side, while those who offer their lives to fight for its elimination will become the champions whom God finds most pleasing. If all 70 million Koreans were determined not to leave this division in place, even at the cost of all their lives, then the unification of the Korean peninsula would be accomplished automatically. But this will not be an easy task.

Wherever such a "38th Parallel" exists, Satan is the owner; and wherever a "38th Parallel" is eliminated, God is the owner. For this reason, the members of the Unification Church who have followed me have carried on a reform movement to digest and remove all of humanity's "38th Parallels," that is, to eliminate all boundaries.

When the day comes when everyone feels desperate to have exchange marriages for their children -- that is, choosing their sons-in-law and daughters-in-law from enemy nationalities -- everything under heaven will automatically be unified as one. Respected guests, this message from Heaven is my gift to you today. Let me remind you again: Wherever there is a boundary, that is where you will find Satan's kinfolk living; wherever people live in harmony and peace without a "38th Parallel," there you are certain to find God's kinfolk -- true people of goodness who have inherited God's lineage.

Respected guests, I am now very interested in pursuing projects to open up a new world of tourism and hobby industries. There are many places throughout the world where people would like to go to live and pursue their leisure activities. Such areas -- whether they are near an international border or in a desert area -- should be owned peacefully and in common by all humanity through a new international and interreligious organization that would be on par with the United Nations. To accomplish this global task, I have already proposed to everyone who follows me that we collect a Total Living Offering Fund. This entire fund will be placed under the Interreligious and International Peace Council, which will stand at the level of a new international organization like the United Nations.

We see in the Bible that during the Old Testament age, animals symbolizing all of creation were sacrificed in the place of human beings. These were cut into two parts and their blood was drained. The left part represented Satan's side, while the right part was on the side of Heaven. This is how the struggle over ownership had been historically carried out. Then, Jesus, God's only begotten Son and first-born, came to earth and shed his blood. In the end, Jesus' physical body was claimed by Satan, while his heart returned to God in the spirit world. Because of humanity's disbelief, Jesus, too, was divided into two on the cross.

After going to the spirit world, Jesus said he would come again, because he must recover his substantial body. His death was a terrible tragedy. The mind and body of Jesus, God's only begotten Son, became divided and, because of this, the spirit world and the physical world remained divided. At the beginning of history, men and



women became divided against each other, as were mind and body, and Jesus came to unify all these. Toward this purpose, he claimed the spirit world's right of ownership, but he must come to earth again to claim ownership on earth as well, and make everything one. What will he do when he comes? He will marry, establishing the true lineage and thereby cre-

ating a true family.

Satan, who seized the physical body of Jesus, God's first-born, continued to hold possession of the earthly world, while God held the heavenly world. After going to the spirit world, Jesus spent 2,000 years preparing the path. While he worked in the spirit world to focus the world of the mind on the goal of unification, he was working in the earthly world by establishing the foundation for Christianity. However, Christianity became divided between Catholicism and Protestantism, which were in the roles of the struggling brothers, Cain and Abel. These adversaries continue to fight each other today. The first-born, in the position of Cain, came to be on the side of Satan, and the second-born,

in the position of Abel, came to be on the side of Heaven. Within this paradigm, history has developed through continual fighting, as people adopted ideas and concepts that resulted in the creation of increasingly more boundaries. Liberation must be brought to this situation.

The Lord who comes again will unify the heavenly kingdom and establish a unified country on earth that fulfills the ideal of the biblical nation of Israel. He will also perform a new model of marriage that creates oneness for the first time between heaven and earth, and between man and woman, who have been fighting each other for thousands of years. This is what Christianity refers to as the "Marriage of the Lamb."

Historically, the period immediately following the Second World War was an excellent opportunity to unite the heavenly world and the earthly world centered on Christianity. The Christian cultural sphere stood in the same position as if it had unified the entire world. It was the best opportunity for Jesus, who had become a victorious supreme leader, to return to the earth, together with the Holy Spirit, centering on the unified Christian cultural sphere on earth. Then, with himself as the groom and the Holy Spirit as the bride, he could have initiated a new marriage that would have brought resolution to all of humanity's problems. Everything in God's creation would have become a peaceful Kingdom of Heaven. This is not a vague or ambiguous notion.

When you look at God's ideal of creation, who was supposed to be the first couple ever to be married? It was Adam and Eve. Unfortunately, Adam and Eve fell, and this resulted in humanity becoming enslaved to thousands, even tens of thousands, of boundaries. But when three things happen -- the walls that originated with Eve are torn down to make the land flat, the positions of Adam and Eve before the Fall are restored, and they are married anew -- then this would be welcomed not only by our ancestors but also by God. When such a world is brought about, this will be the Kingdom of God on Earth.

This has never happened in human history. Until now, human beings have been slaves, entangled and tormented within countless boundaries. They have lived their lives groaning in agony. If we can only find the answer to the question of how to abolish all boundaries, this will also be the first step toward human peace. Until this moment, humanity has lived in ignorance of this.

Now, for the first time in history, I have appeared on this earth in the capacity of True Parent. I am teaching this answer, and giving the new Holy Marriage Blessing, in the presence of God, to all good men and women for all to see. Even if there were a million boundaries in the world, it would not be a problem for me. They can be eliminated easily. How can this be so? It is possible because of true love. Unless a person knows God 100 percent and stands in the same position as God, it is impossible to resolve such a situation.

In the spirit world, there is hell and heaven. If we compare heaven to the daytime, hell is like the night. How can a person who has not experienced both day and night exercise control over the borderline between heaven and hell? There is no way. Only a person who knows the content can naturally come to exercise control. Only the person who knows with certainty the content of hell can wipe away the darkness.

God is omnipotent and omniscient, so He is able to wipe away the darkness. The problem is for us to come to know God. How well do you know God? Does He like money? Does He like power? Or is He only interested in knowledge? If God were like this, we could not be certain about humanity's eventual liberation.

It is only when we know God completely that we can banish Satan completely and bring total resolution to the issue of boundaries. We need to know what God has that can be used to resolve the age-old problem of boundaries. This is important. If God is the owner of the universe, should there not be a neighborhood and a country where this owner lives? If we are to know God, then we must stand in the reciprocal position to God and go in search of that country where we can become members of the royal family.

All environments, though, are cut off by various kinds of boundaries, so it is by eliminating these boundaries that we can go about creating a world that God will find pleasing. When that happens, all creation will want to receive God's direct dominion. They will want to be liberated from the rule of the devil, which has brought persecution, agony, and the weight of countless boundaries.

Respected leaders, it is most important that we know God with certainty and know the heavenly world, or spirit world, with certainty. Just do this, and no matter the time or the place, you will be able to figure out how to adapt and deal with any situation.

God definitely lives in the heavenly world. How can it be, then, that the world in which we live is divided by thousands and tens of thousands of boundaries? It has become such a nonsensical world, because not only is there no one who knows God correctly and

knows the heavenly world, but also there is no one who knows the content of the tradition of the heavenly world. When we come to know that content with certainty, a realm of liberation will appear in the spirit world and in the earthly world. All we need do is become a true person who is knowledgeable about all the secrets of the heavenly world and capable of immobilizing Satan. Then we will come to know how to live in a culture and tradition that lets us be as one body with heavenly law. Such a person is a true person who embodies "true love that lives for the sake of others." This is not a person who seeks selfish love for his or her own sake only, but a true person who makes it possible for his or her partner to become an owner of true love. A true person sacrifices everything for the sake of his or her partner and makes it possible for the partner to dance and live within true love. Such a true person becomes

will turn around 180 degrees and rise up into the heavenly kingdom. The blessing of eternal life will be given. By becoming a true person who knows God with certainty, knows the spirit world with certainty, and can practice "true love for the sake of others," which is the traditional philosophy of the heavenly world, you become qualified for the first time to refer to God as your "Father." It is only in this position that the link in the lineage between parent and child is established, and it is only through this heavenly lineage that the logic and tradition of eternal life are decisively and inseparably attached to you.

Eternal life is an essential attribute of true love. When God created the universe, He did so with the standards of absolute faith, absolute love, and absolute obedience. Please understand that God pours out His true love for eternity regardless of how the world may change

that has continued throughout history? Because this is something committed by the false parent, only the person who comes as the True Parent of humankind can set it right.

Distinguished guests who are concerned about the world and cherish the desire for peace among humankind: In this time, which is the final fruit-bearing season in human history, Heaven has sent me to this earth as the Savior, Messiah, returning Lord, and True Parent of humankind. I received Heaven's command at the young age of 16, and have followed it ever since. My life of more than 80 years has been focused on just one thing -- to complete the Kingdom of God on Earth and in Heaven according to the desire that God has treasured since the beginning of time. I have experienced all manner of persecution so unimaginably intense that the six billion people on earth today would not be able to endure even if they

joined their hearts together as one. Even in the midst of that, I stood on the standard of absolute faith, absolute love, and absolute obedience to God and completed all restoration through indemnity for the sake of humankind. The power of Satan has now been completely eradicated from the earth.

Now a new world is opening up for humankind. I have already founded the Federation of Island Nations, the Federation of Peninsular Nations, and the Federation of Continental Nations in the spirit world and the earthly world. Not only that, while you were unaware, humanity has already entered the third year of Cheon

II Guk (the Kingdom of God). Not only has the lost realm of the first Israel been restored, but I have also completed the declaration before God and the cosmos of the start of the "Fourth Israel Nation." In the spirit world, the leaders of the five great religions and 120 billion new blessed families have formed a oneness based on my absolute standard and are standing at the forefront in the effort to build a world of peace.

Your mission now is to engrave into your memory the meaning of my declaration today regarding "The New Elimination of Boundaries and World Peace," return to your communities, and be the first to practice true love in your family, society, nation, and world for the purpose of building the Kingdom of Heaven on Earth and in Heaven. I believe that you will devote your full efforts to the Interreligious and International Peace Council, which we have formed together here today as a body on the level of a new Abel-like United Nations.

I hope that each of you will make a determination to live for the sake of liberating true love and that God's blessing may be with you as you return home. Thank you. ❖



an heir to the heavenly world and is protected and loved by the heavenly world. Satan cannot lay a hand on such an heir to the heavenly world.

When we go beyond feeling anger at the sight of someone being killed and instead live for the sake of our enemy with true love, then we can rule the world of the enemy, and Satan automatically withdraws. The world of the enemy will come to respect and attend you. If you live for the sake of those around you and give them true love to a greater extent than you would your own children or parents, Satan will automatically withdraw. God will come and fill that position instead and repay you thousands and tens of thousands of times over.

What did I say is the secret to forcing Satan to run away? Even if he runs away, he cannot do so without first tearing down the boundaries. What will happen then? Because Satan has left, a process of eternal life will unfold in which all those countless numbers of people who were sent straight to hell

or pass away. So it is impossible for there to be any existence that is not subject to God's governance or does not attend God as the absolute, unique, unchanging, and eternal owner. When human beings, who were created to have eternal life, become God's sons and daughters, and stand in a position of oneness with God, His Kingdom becomes our kingdom and God becomes a personal God for each of us. When, in our daily lives, we are one with God, the traditional owner of the heavenly world, and there is no room to doubt that we are His son or daughter, then it will be only natural that we enjoy eternal life and immortality. That is why there is truth in the paradoxical statement, "Those who seek to lose their life for the sake of Heaven will live, and those who seek to live for themselves will die."

In eliminating boundaries, we must address the boundaries within the United Nations. We must also eliminate religious boundaries, ethnic boundaries, and the boundary between hell and heaven. Boundaries were originally created by false parents, so no one except the True Parents can eliminate them. Even God cannot do it, because He did not establish them. Satan absolutely will not do it. Who can bring an end to the conflict between Satan and God

Are there more men or women here? If we look at religious organizations, they are mostly 75 % women. When I look at you here, many here are fighting with their wives.

I will declare something new today. Unification Church has Cosmic Parents. There must be more than just one. There must be a subject and object. God cannot be parent alone. He needs to have his object partner to be parent. He must have True Parents on earth to stand as the eternal True Parent. When we talk about the place of settlement or the place of peace. The Pledge Service was guided by Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak. The offering table was set with the traditional settings of fruit, cookies and representative food items of all the creation. There were large dark brown wooden bowls with grain, spices, corn and barley in the front of the altar. True Parents entered to our applause. Father looks magnificent - very healthy and ageless. Mother looked brilliant in a red formal sweater jacket and a light purple dress. Father wore a dark gray suit complimented by a dark maroon striped tie.

Father lit the 7 candles in the front of the offering table. First the center, then the far right, then the far left, then the next on the right then the left from outside to the center. Then Father and Mother began with prayer. True Parents then gave Kyung Beh to God. Afterward, they walked to the back of the offering table together. (As with True Day of All Things this is a new tradition signifying that True Parents are one. It used to be that Mother would bow to Father as this point. Now they go to the throne as King and Queen of all Blessed Families as one.) Next, the True Children bowed. (Another new point here is that Dae Mo Nim is now asked to bow with the True Family together).

The most important thing is what Chun Jo Chun Ji Po Mo Nim. Parents of heaven and earth. Pyeong Hwa (Peace), Peace requires two to become one. Rev. Kwak, Rev. Hwang do you understand. Today, on the 44th True Children's Day, I am announcing the Parents of Heaven , Earth and Man. This makes God happy. Cosmic Parents and the parents of heaven. You are in the position to be the fruits that can bring heaven and

Three weeks after the Inaugural Assembly of the IIPC, that was held Oct. 3, 2003, over twenty-five distinguished advisors with experience in international organizations gathered in New York at the New Yorker Hotel, October 28-30, 2003, for a special planning consultation. Together they worked to outline and create working documents to support the progress of the Peace Council.

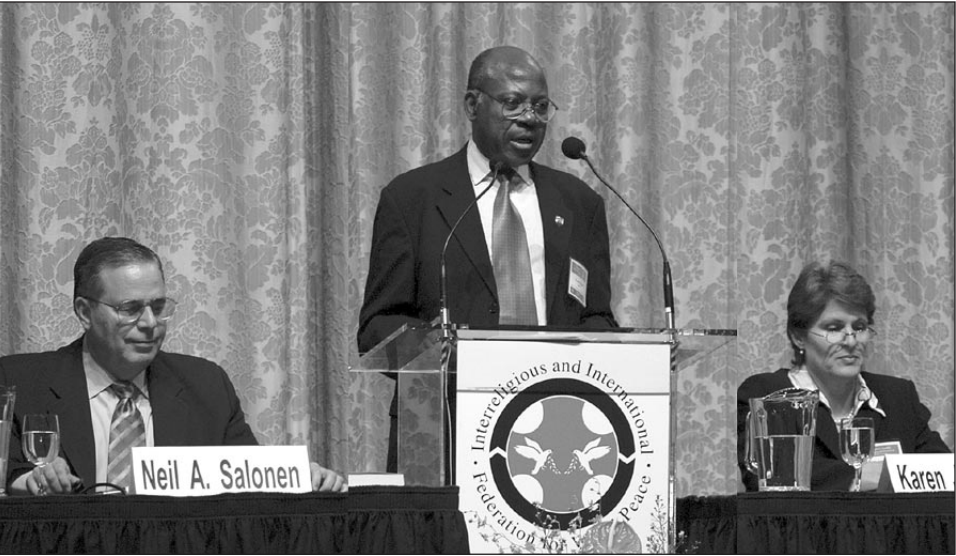
The IIPC Consultation had four sessions. The first dealt with "Global Governance in Crisis." This, however, was not a what-are-the-problems session. Instead it looked for ways the IIPC could help resolve the urgent crisis facing international governance. One of the important contributions that the United Nations has made, it was noted, was in fostering international cooperation among member states and this should be acknowledged and strengthened.

In the second session, titled, "Toward a 'Concept Paper'," delegates explored the vision and the strength of such a peace council. The fact that the IIPC was not a government body was seen as a possible strength. This was because the UN, although an international body,

sponsored the event.

This was seen as the pinnacle of the Founder's lifelong work and undying quest for world peace. Notwithstanding his more than half century of public life, the more immediate underpinning for launching the Peace Council was laid during this past summer. IIFWP held both broad-based and grassroots programs. One-day seminars in 158 nations around the world were held during a two month period while the Federation simultaneously carried out international conferences in three strategic areas of global concern: Jerusalem, Israel; Washington DC, USA, and Seoul, Korea. In essence, both the grassroots as well as the international nature of IIFWP could be observed. But even more important, and more than just a show of strength, this demonstrated the serious investment, financial sacrifice, and



unshakable commitment this organization and its Founder has to creating world peace.

At the end of this Assembly, the Hon. Sam H. Zakhem, the Former U.S. Ambassador to Bahrain concluded, "Rev. Moon has built a strong following throughout the world. He now has a great reser-

nonetheless has no jurisdiction in sovereign nations unless invited. On the contrary, the strength of IIFWP's grassroots foundation could be seen from the fact that it held seminars this summer in 151 countries where 194 nations were represented.

When issues dealing with organizational structures were discussed in the third session, delegates pointed out a number of successful models of international organizations, i.e. the Red Cross and the Rotary Club, which should be considered when setting up the legal structure of IIPC.

The fourth session dealt with "Developing a Plan of Action." A number of proposals were on the table, including:

- * Fostering dialogue between the Maoist and Nepalese government leaders
- * Supporting such programs as the UN's Dialogue Among Civilizations initiative
- * Developing a conceptual framework for IIPC
- * Continuing efforts in Israel, Palestine (Gaza) and even consider inviting Israelis and Palestinians to Cyprus for

voir of good will that could help bring about harmony between people and friendships among nations." But, Ambassador Zakhem cautioned, "We should be planning for the next stage, namely the implementation stage. We need to reach out to our respective governments to espouse the principles of IIPC."

His advice was heeded. Within two weeks after the its inauguration, a selected number of delegates reconvened in New York City for an IIPC Consultation--a planning session lasting three days.

They will be reviewing, among other things, the "Inaugural Declaration" drafted and signed by delegates of the IIPC inauguration. The heart and spirit of the proclamation was not to point fingers or lay blame, although it did begin by calling for serious self-reflection. The purpose was to learn from shortcomings, identify areas that can be improved, and refocus on the vital task of establishing models of good governance. The declaration began:

Whereas, we are going through a most critical time in history that requires each of us to re-examine both ourselves and our institutions of global governance, including the United Nations, and to search for ways and means to go beyond past achievements in a renewed effort to prevent the suffering

* Researching resources of the world's religions that support the idea of peace

* Establishing peacemaking institutes for the education of peacemaking tactics and methods

* Creating educational literature on peace that can be published for daily readings by families, thus educating for peace along with developing literacy skills

At the conclusion, Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak, the Chairman of the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace, explained that peaceful relationships are developed when people think more about giving than receiving. Challenging each delegate Rev. Kwak said that the IIPC movement should be a model of



peace to both the secular world and the world of religion. Each person, he emphasized, "must overcome the religious barriers of ritual and doctrine, since God exists in a realm beyond religion. Then the IIPC can truly serve the world and foster peace." ♦

* Address the Critical Issues Facing Island Nations

During the morning session on October 3rd, the Founder of IIFWP addressed the delegates and day-guests totaling 1,200 people. The Founder's Address, which Rev. Moon called his "gift" to the Assembly, dealt with the topic, The New Elimination of Boundaries and World Peace. He said that people have to overcome self-imposed barriers of race, religion and culture and that there are three things each person has to know for certainty: the existence of God, the existence of the spiritual world, and the practice of "true love for the sake of others." This level of oneness of heart creates the unbreakable "link in the lineage between parent and child." Once you reach this level of maturity and spirituality, you are ultimately qualified to refer to God as your "Father," not by faith alone but now aided with unquestionable, experiential convictions as well.

Following the Inaugural Session and lunch, participants attended the "Peace Under One God" rally. This was held at the Dag Hammarskjold Plaza, just opposite the United Nations. But it was not a protest! It was a rally of support for the august world body. On a cool autumn day, with a jumbotron behind the stage and 10,000 men, women and children gathered to support new and innovative approaches to global governance, the program outlined four steps to world peace:

1. Living for the sake of others
2. Building families of true love
3. Interreligious reconciliation and cooperation, and
4. The proper role and function of the United Nations

Media coverage, electronic and print, drew more than 20 newsmen and women from nine nations. United Press International quoted H.E. Abdurrahman Wahid, former president of Indonesia as saying, "The idea of establishing the IIPC is an excellent idea." ♦

IIPC Consultation: Opening Remarks

I would like to take a few moments here at the outset to provide an overview of the broader framework for our discussions. In particular, I want to share some points related to the Founder's vision for world peace and the IIPC.

Throughout his entire life, Father Moon has been following the call of God, beginning with his experience with Jesus, as a 16-year-old boy, while praying in the mountains near his home in what is now North Korea. The simplest way to express his mission in life is to say that he is absolutely committed to working to establish the Kingdom of God. The term "world peace" is another way of speaking about the Kingdom of God.

To establish God's Kingdom is not a simple matter. Otherwise, it would have been achieved long ago. God certainly does not oppose the accomplishment of His original ideal. In order to establish God's kingdom, there needs to be a coalition of factors working together. These factors have to do with there being a central figure in God's providence, the right time frame, and the right conditions.

I will not be vague as I think many of you know that within our movement we refer to Rev. and Mrs. Moon as True Parents. This term is not only a term of honor for them, but represents a very important status in God's providence. What various religions have referred to as messiah, savior, anointed one, or the second coming, is included in the term True Parents. This is the position that Adam and Eve were to have taken, had they not fallen. If Adam and Eve had not fallen, there would be no need for a savior and no need for religion at all. A savior is needed and religions are needed only to help overcome sin and restore fallen mankind back to God. Once fully restored, we no longer need a savior or a religious vehicle.

My point is simply to state up front that Rev. Moon is not an ordinary man, but stands in a position to lead God's providence at this time.

Secondly, it is not only that he is a man chosen by God, but also that the time we live in is a turning point in history. It is a time when God is intervening directly in human affairs, on the foundation of not only Rev. Moon's mission and work, but also the good conditions of the founders of all the religions, along with other saints, sages and conscientious leaders from the past. The time we live in is a time of harvest. It is a time when the fruit is ripe and ready to be harvested.

Although I am speaking from a religious point of view, I think you can also understand, even from a humanitarian, or moral, or social perspective that we are living at a very critical juncture in history. Something needs to be done to put an end to the suffering of humanity and to bring each precious human being to a point where they can fulfill their God-given hopes and aspirations.

Rev. Moon is both a very religious man and a very practical man. While he is a man of prayer, he is also a man of action.

In thinking of how to transform the world he thinks very logically.

First of all, individuals must be transformed through direct experience of God's love and truth.

However, he also knows that in order to establish world peace, the family itself must become a social unit that manifests

and expresses the love and truth of God. The family is the place where new human life is conceived, born and nurtured. It is also the school of love and ethics.

Along these lines he has initiated the Holy Blessing or the World Peace Blessing. This ceremony has both a very practical and a very spiritual significance. Spiritually, it represents the restoration of the Fall of Adam and Eve. Adam and Eve were expelled from the Garden of Eden, and then bore their children. In other words, their children were disconnected from God's lineage. These Blessings brings men and women back into God's direct lineage.

But the Blessing also provides a vision for family life that underscores the profound social significance of the family institution. For, when the family is stable, secure and loving, then society is also solid and unwavering. Good families and good parenting create children of good character who become good students, good citizens, good employees and professionals, good friends and ultimately become good husbands and wives, and good parents.

To establish God's kingdom, religion has a central role. It is to represent God's words of truth as well as the principles and practices we are to live by. Unfortunately, religious people have often been at the forefront of disharmony, sectarianism, and narrow-minded absolutism. For this reason, Rev. Moon has always advocated interreligious harmony and cooperation. He has encouraged all his followers to cultivate a respect for people of all religions, to develop a broad awareness and consciousness toward those of other faith traditions.

If religious leaders cooperate together, they can become a powerful force for good in the world.

Rev. Moon not only works among religious people, he also understands that to transform the world, it is necessary to reach people in all fields, including academia, education, media, the sciences, sports, the arts, NGOs, etc., so that through these leaders and their respective institutions, a message of peace can be presented.

Rev. Moon started the IIFWP in 1999, on the foundation of more than 50 years of effort in a wide range of areas, including interreligious dialogue, interdisciplinary dialogue among scholars, and the promotion of a moral and spiritual awareness among various professional communities such as the media, academia, etc.

The uniqueness of the IIFWP is twofold. First it seeks to integrate the potential of religious insight and religious influence into the effort to solve global problems. In this sense, Rev. Moon is taking interreligious dialogue a further step, seeking to bring those who have been able to move beyond sectarian narrowness toward cooperation, and calling them to now work cooperatively with others in governments, NGOs, international organi-

zations to solve critical problems.

This vision of interreligious and international governance was expressed in his proposal to the United Nations to establish an interreligious council.

In his mind, the current charter and structure of the UN system is lacking a necessary component-religion. Religion is simply too important in human history, both in terms of its moral force and in terms of its sociological significance, to be either excluded or ignored.

In 1945 when the UN was formed, the exclusion of religion no doubt seemed reasonable, given the immediate urgency to try to prevent future world wars,

especially realizing that some accommodation with the Soviet bloc seemed necessary for the UN to succeed. The exclusion of religion was taken for granted by many during the Cold War era. For example, the ideology of communism was officially atheistic, while at the same time, many Western democracies are officially secular.

But in this post-Cold War era, we must review this dominant paradigm. It is outdated. We should not be dominated exclusively by either 19th century ideologies or by Cold War political analysis.

As you know, there is currently a proposal being worked out by the Philippines to establish an interreligious council at the UN. IIFWP continues to support this effort and remains on good terms with our friends both in Manila and at the Philippines Mission. IIFWP of course is not a member state, but an NGO, so, we hope many other member states will support and co-sponsor the Philippine initiative.

Rev. Moon wants to see the United Nations fully renewed. Even an interreligious council will not necessarily mean the UN will be able to bring peace to humanity. It will depend on the level of quality and authority that the council has. For this reason, Rev. Moon continues to move forward with a vision to provide a model of good global governance. This is the purpose of the IIPC.

This is a major historical development. In his mind, peace is not just a concept or slogan, nor a distant hope, but a reality that is coming into being at this time. The world of peace is a unified world under God, with no borders or boundaries, and no discrimination. Furthermore, as committed people intermarry across lines of religion, race, nationality, culture, and class, etc., we will see a breaking down of barriers. Along with this, there will be a move toward equalization of wealth, technology and information.

A true realm of peace calls for increasing equality of living conditions. As each person is transformed and develops a God-centered character, he or she begins to live for the sake of others, going beyond personal self-interest. As this happens, a world of true love becomes possible.

God truly does not like borders, discrimination, inequality and conflict. He

wants only that we live as one family, as God's true sons and daughters.

Think about it, please. We can never reach peace as long as there are so many different levels of material wealth. There must be a process of equalization. Those who have wealth and prosperity must devote themselves more to assisting, serving and supporting those in greater need so they can improve their level of prosperity. There is no alternative to this. It is our destiny. Peace cannot just be an empty slogan. It calls for revolutionary action. We have to examine our lifestyle and change the way we live.

In relation to this, we also need to develop our understanding and appreciation of spirit world. We will all go there after our time on this earth. The spiritual world is a substantial reality, and not just a concept. It is a real, true world. There are no boundaries or borders there. Just imagine our ancestors living there. Also think about the saints and sages of history, are they living apart? Are there borders? What are the laws and principles that guide life in the spiritual world? The core and most absolute principle is the standard of true love, the principle of living for the sake of others.

But let me get back to the discussion of the IIPC.

Rev. Moon refers to the IIPC as the "Abel UN." What does he mean by this unusual terminology? Rev. Moon also thinks about the roots of our global problems and those roots take us back to the Fall of Adam's family. As you recall, not only did Adam and Eve Fall, but their children suffered the results of the Fall too.

Among Adam's children, Abel was a relatively more God-centered person. Cain, the elder brother, killed his younger brother. In God's ideal, however, Cain should not have killed Abel, but the two should have learned to love one another, forgive one another and reconcile with each another. For this to happen, it is Abel's mission to love and embrace his elder brother Cain.

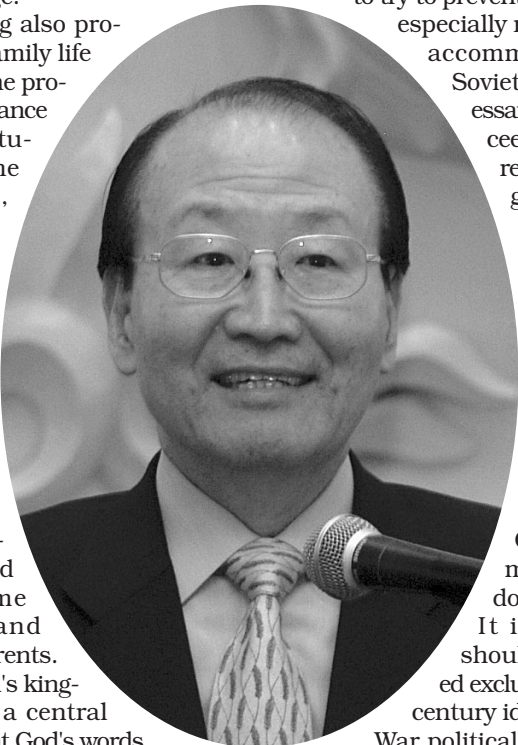
Rev. Moon wants the IIPC to be an "Abel UN," that is, an institution that is God-centered and that lives for the sake of others.

He wants the IIPC or "Abel UN" to be an example of good governance and to apply these core principles in its practices and to its programs. He also wants the IIPC to work cooperatively with the United Nations, and to serve and support that institution as it seeks to fulfill its own global mission.

It is Rev. Moon's hope that the IIPC and the UN will come to a close, cooperative and productive working relationship. If this comes about, it will represent a new era for the UN. He refers to this stage as the era of the "Peace UN."

Actually, he is already thinking of the "Peace UN." The true meaning of peace, freedom, happiness, and unification is related to God, and being centered on God's true love. When we are centered on God's true love, true and lasting peace will follow.

Ultimately, however, the goal is to build God's Kingdom, or what Rev. Moon calls the Peace Kingdom. The Peace Kingdom represents simply the universal hope and aspiration of all people, based on their God-given original nature that seeks a world of peace, happiness, freedom and unification. This is also IIPC's long-term goal. ❖

So far, the spirit world continued to progress, based on the victorious foundation of our Parents of Heaven and Earth. And I would like to offer you a report, focusing on the activities of the spirit world and the founders of the 5 major religions.

In the original world, art, culture, sports, etc. are to be mediators to build an ideal environment of the Kingdom of Heaven on earth, as the expressions corresponding to the environment of the Kingdom of Heaven in the spirit world. Peace Cup Tournament was, through sports, to let human beings see and feel with their own mind and body dynamic harmony and the world of unity that could be shown in the beautiful environment of the Kingdom of Heaven. It was also to connect the world of unity and harmony in the Kingdom of Heaven to the physical world, in order to create a ground of the unity and harmony of humankind. Thus, this event became a great turning point to demonstrate the original value of sports.

In the Summit Meeting for World Peace which was held in August, our Father emphasized the importance of changing the character, mind, heart of human beings, and especially the ideology of human beings in order to bring eternal peace in the true world. For harmony and peace, all nations and reli-

gious bodies should repent their wrongdoings in the past, and resolve themselves anew for world peace. For this, spirit world will work hard.

Further, in order for the world to launch a new history of peace and be resolved to extinguish the sufferings from wars, diseases, and poverty, our Father established an inter-religious committee at the United Nations.

In order to be in line with the providence of the Parents of Heaven and Earth from the Summit Meeting to the Seoul Declaration for world peace, spirit world is also resolved to march forward for the building of God's Nation and world peace through harmony and peace in the spirit world. For this, it is striving to bring unity and harmony among religions, through spirits of absolute goodness who are now being educated.

Currently in the spirit world, representatives of the 5 major religions, who had been already Blessed are actively working with the spirits of absolute goodness, visiting and persuading the spirits of the same religion, but who are not Blessed yet. It is to have them be engrafted to the Parents of Heaven and Earth. The representative of each religion explains the Principle to them, focusing on the same teachings of their own religion. In the meantime, they continued educating on the Principle, how to remove the original sin and how

to inherit true love from the Parents of Heaven and Earth. During the education, they are taught that the Creator is only one God, and therefore, in order to create the world of the original creation centering on God, everyone must be engrafted to the Parents of Heaven and Earth.

However, it is not easy for the representatives of the 5 major religions to witness to spirits and educate them. This is as if earthly people with barriers should first break down their own barriers and be open

in order to have a heart to heart communication. Likewise, even spirits, although invisible to our own physical eyes, also have barriers towards other religions.

Likewise, in the spirit world as well, having spirit selves open their hearts requires tremendous endeavor, which is more difficult than witnessing to earthly persons.

That is why the Parents of Heaven and Earth made proclamations of breaking down barriers in the spirit world on the number of occasions, including the one in the United Nations. Especially, on a Korean traditional thanksgiving day, Choosuk in 2000, the Parents of Heaven and Earth led the "Ceremony

of Dissolving Total Grievances" and the "Ceremony of Liberating the Spirit World" through which the barriers in the spirit world were broken down, and spirit selves could travel to visit one other. So, in order to open their spiritual senses, education should continue, along with the Cheong Pyung providence.

The representatives of the 5 major religions are diligently working so that each religion can be united with the Parents of Heaven and Earth. They deeply respect the Parents of Heaven and Earth who are so loving to all humankind, transcending religions. They are also grateful for their profound grace and great love, solving the problems that they themselves cannot, such as removing the original sin and/or establishing the four position foundation, etc.

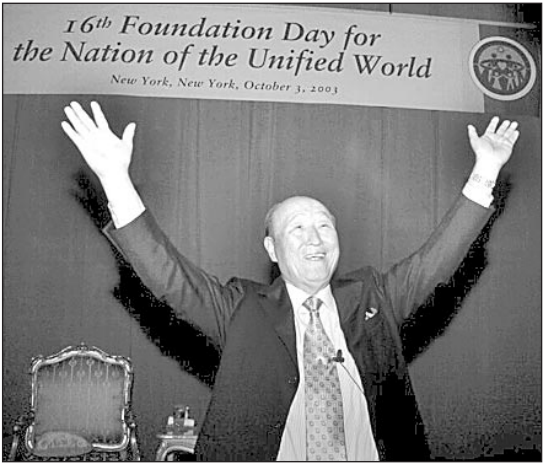

(After the President's Messages) This is the first time in history this has been revealed. Now we must all connect with this heavenly time period and focus on God's will for the world. If you don't connect with this providence you will lose your fortune. We must fulfill God's will. If we don't fulfill then even Heung Jin Nim will suffer in the spiritual world.

You must take these messages to the descendants of the Presidents. Also you must wake up the American people.

The Seven-Nation Mobilization

In the course of the recent Mobilization of 840 people to the New York metro area, some 84 of these international delegates found their way onto the UN Team. For a period of up to six weeks, (with some leaving earlier to join the delegation to Korea and/or Jerusalem), these volunteers helped highlight the endeavors of the IIFWP to transform global thinking about the most direct means to establishing a culture of peace. Through meetings and the distribution of key materials (World Scriptures, God and World Peace: An Exploration of the Significance of God for a World in Crisis and the messages World Peace through True Love), average New Yorkers along with presidents of nations, ministers of foreign affairs, ambassadors and members of delegations coming to New York city for the opening of the UN's 58th Session of the General Assembly were urged to consider the substantial reality of the spiritual dimensions of human life which are essential elements to consider in the course of seeking solutions to global crises. This was a unique and transforming experience the many who were involved.

To be effective and prepared, the 84 members of the UN Team were oriented in how to work within the international environment alongside delegates from all nations coming to New York for the 58th Session of the United Nations. The UN Team participated in the International Day of Peace activities around the United Nations, made appointments and met with Ambassadors, Ministers of Foreign Affairs, national presidents, NGO leaders, people working in the UN secretariat and other national delegates as well as many New Yorkers working or touring the areas around the United Nations.

The opportunities afforded those who responded to the call to come to New York at this time was memorable and excellent training for many as IIFWP seeks to expand its international and grassroots outreach through the establishment of the Interreligious and International Peace Councils... at the global, regional, national and community levels through the Ambassadors for Peace and the local IIFWP chapters and affiliated organizations such as Family Federation for World Peace and Unification, etc.

As most know, the Philippines some time back, indicated their seriousness about the establishment of an Interreligious Council during the 58th Session of the UN General Assembly. IIFWP then began to support this initiative strongly by conducting many seminars worldwide which informed people of the work at hand. Amazingly, we all found that there was a remarkable "spirit of the times" that allowed people to quickly respond. So much of the initial international work was to get this "idea whose time had come" into the minds and hearts of religious and political people alike worldwide. This has been accomplished to varying degrees in so many nations. The levels of support for the idea are still mixed, and there remains a great amount of education required for national and inter-

national leaders as well as community leaders to fully comprehend the value of such an approach/initiative.

This work continues and will pick up pace as key strategic moments are passed in the natural course of events at the UN. The Philippines decided not to present this resolution at the UN until after they had secured their seat in the Security Council. That was accomplished Thurs. morning 23rd October 2003.

23rd October marked the 58th UN Day. On this day as he sent his message to people around the world, the Secretary-General Kofi Annan began by noting, "These are difficult times, for the world and for the United Nations." He went on to note, "it may be necessary to make changes in our international system, including the United Nations itself. By and large, I believe our Organization has served humanity well for fifty-eight years. But it has never been perfect, and the time may well have come to improve it....

"In the end, governments will decide. But they will make the effort to reach agreement only if you, the peoples, tell them clearly what you expect—what kind of



world you want to live in. I rely on you to do that. And I believe that if you do make your voices heard, loudly and firmly enough, we can indeed win through this crisis and build a better world, based on the rule of law. Let us all persevere, in the knowledge that we are all contributing to a better future, for ourselves and for our children."

On this same day, IIFWP delivered to the Secretary-General's office the "Box of 10,000 Prayers for Peace." Early in October at the time of the founding of the Interreligious and International Peace Council, we had put out the call to all IIFWP chapters world-wide for signatures of those prepared to pray for the UN and the Secretary General as well as their head of state. Within about one week (including the efforts of the UN Team in New York) we collected 10,227 signatures from 31 nations. Each of these signatures, that also noted the nation, was cut into a single small slip of paper and put in a beautify leather box. This became the "Box of 10,000 Prayers for Peace" and was taken to the SG on Friday 23rd October. Now he can open it and pick out any signature, see the country and know that that person is praying for him and the UN in these critical times. ♦

Hyun Jin Nim’s Core Values in Second Generation Youth Ministry and CARP

I was part of a group of World CARP leaders, STF members and Youth Ministers that returned from Hyun Jin Nim’s first Alaska Adventure Workshop, hosted by World CARP. It was an amazing learning experience. From a pure structural standpoint, this workshop was unique in that it used the extreme physical challenge offered by the Alaskan wilderness as an experiential way to learn life lessons through the Core Values.

In other words, it was a direct experience in living for the greater good, taking ownership, teamwork, dreaming big, and aligning ourselves vertically to God. It was as if Hyun Jin Nim imparted to us the path he had taken, overcoming great suffering and hardships. He wanted us to connect to the heart of God by understanding even a fraction of the historic course True Parents walked. We came face to face with our limitations, forced to assess our contribution to the good of our team. We had to work together to accomplish the big goal we were all aiming for. This meant that each individual had to take ownership of his or her own responsibilities and physical body. No matter how rubbery my legs were from march-

ing all day up and down the rugged terrain, I still had to push myself to crawl into the trees and pitch a bivouac before it became too dark to see.

In reaching my physical limits, I could see with amazing clarity my own mental and emotional limitations. I have returned knowing what I must focus on improving in myself. It is sobering to see that any complacency in your heart can result in great physical discomfort or at worst, a life-threatening situation. In the wilderness, there is no such thing as negotiation or compromise. Stripped to your bare needs, you must act productively, or perish. It is life distilled to its essence, and powerful insight into how to live our daily lives.

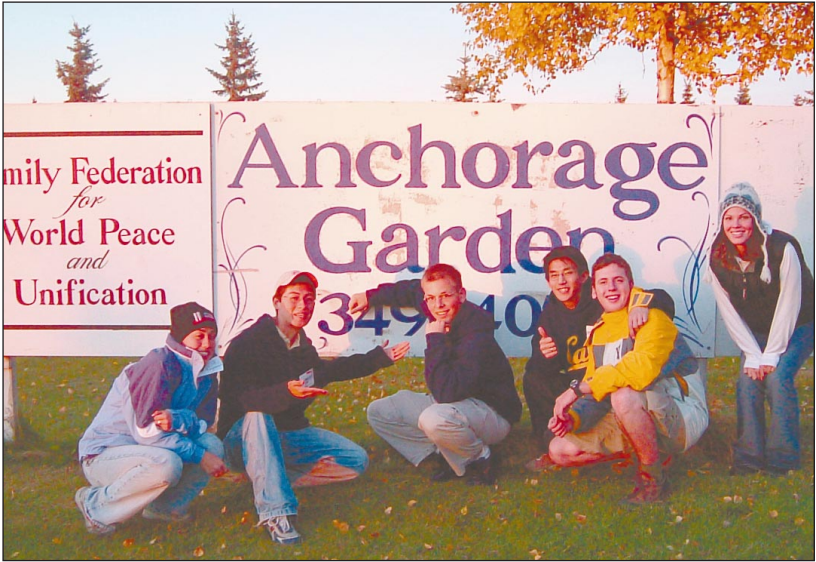
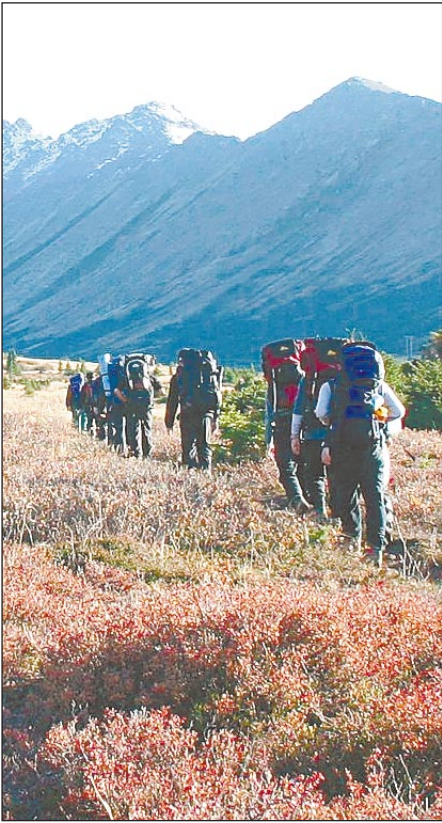
In order to succeed in life, we must approach those things we hold dear with an all-or-nothing attitude. We must constantly invest ourselves in a higher purpose that is aligned with the will of God and True Parents, or

our lives will stagnate. As I learned from my team during the expedition phase of the workshop, you’ve got to keep putting one foot in front of the other. Spiritual life is a constant effort to grow and become a better person through understanding the heart of God. Our True Parents have shown us the way with their living testimony.

Hyun Jin Nim’s Core Values showed me how to cultivate a life of faith that is not only spiritual, but effective. For those unfamiliar with the terms, the Core Values are Living for the Greater Good, Ownership, Teamwork and Dream Big. These are powerful concepts that substantiate True Parents’ dream, by applying Divine Principle in how we substantiate our life goals and aspirations. The following is how I personally used the Core Values in my work with the Youth Ministry.

I have been involved with the Youth Ministry of our church in the Northern California Region for about seven years, minus some periods of inactivity. What drives me is the conviction that this is my offering to God and True Parents. Our region has a Youth

About one hundred CARP and Second Generation leaders from around the world convened in Anchorage Garden Alaska for HJN’s 1st annual Alaska Adventure Workshop, and I happened to be one of them. My mission for the past 2 years has been working with CARP at the University of Maryland, so being asked to attend a CARP youth leaders workshop didn’t seem that much out of the ordinary, even if it was in Alaska. Little did I know that this would not be a typical workshop. The W-CARP epistemology emphasizes that experiential learning should be the subject relative to cognitive learning. So instead of having a workshop full of lectures, HJN wanted to have a workshop full of experiential learning, in this case out in God’s expansive Alaskan wilderness.

Honestly speaking this is one of the most productive workshops I’ve ever participated in. While attending lectures are always beneficial, one doesn’t absorb so much of the content many times. In fact it is through experience that a person will final “own” the content of a given lecture. Many brothers and sisters, myself included, have not been able to understand much of the value of Core Values up to this point, but through this workshop we all gained first hand experience. The focus on experiencing Core Values as opposed to theorizing about how to apply and experience Core Values is what made this experience valuable. Each day we made fulfilling a specific Core Value our goal, and then at the end of the day reflected on how well we lived up to that goal. It is difficult to summarize just how necessary HJN’s Core Values are in creating success, except that I could see clearly how embodying Core Values contributed to our successes, and how not embodying them led to our failures as a team.

While the first three days of the workshop were good preparation for the outdoor expedition, it was the expedition itself where I learned the most and surpassed numerous limitations. According to HJN only 25% of the challenge in sports is physical, but that 75% of our limitations exist in our own minds, and I was absolutely amazed at how much truth is in that observation. As the expedition wore on my physical body felt more and more fatigued and by the third day our entire team was in a considerable amount of pain. Yet we persevered and continued to march forward. Even when we thought we would never complete our goal of seeing a glacier, our team marched forward and claimed victory at the mouth of the glacier. The bottom line was that no matter how much I or anyone else wanted to stop, we didn’t. Through this I could realize just how many of my limitations exist solely in my mind, and I know the same is true when I encounter challenges as a CARP member or

Second Generation UN Day of Peace

Friday 19th of September saw the beginning of the International Day of Peace, a day celebrated worldwide to promote cease fires in warring nations and friendship amongst foes. The meeting was supposed to be fully attended by various youth organizations from numerous nations. However, because of the hurricane that crossed the North Eastern coast of the USA, many of these groups were unable to attend. That is why the 'World Peace Prayer Society' (the group which organized the event) called to our UN IIFWP representative in desperation—they wanted to know....”do you have any young people who can attend our meeting”.

For this reason, 29 mainly European second generation, involved in the World Peace Task Force in New York, were able at short notice to attend the meeting. The program started off with an opening ceremony attended by several celebrities and delegates and Koffi Annan the UN Secretary General. Brief speeches were given, followed by the ringing of the 'peace bell', rung only during 3 very auspicious occasions in the year. After this, the celebrities including three times world heavyweight champion Muhammad Ali, Actor Michael Douglas and writer Elie Weisel along with several photographers and onlookers, were shepherded into the conference room number 4 where the event unfolded. The whole experience was romanced in music by Ms. Alysun Panichi and her band



'The Kwaziwas', singing songs of peace and harmony. Once everyone was settled, the main program began with an introduction from Mr. Shahshi Tharoor—the Under Secretary General and a welcome from Mrs. Nane Annan. Then six selected youth made brief presentations about their nations followed by questions directed at the 'celebrity peace messengers'. These youths included representatives from America, Rwanda and Kuwait, and also youths connected via satellite from Sierra Leone, Afghanistan and Syria. Each one had their own experiences with war and conflict. The girl from Rwanda found herself an orphan after the genocide in her country. A young man from Sierra Leone was once a 'child soldier'. Everyone agreed that it was amazing to see the positive attitude of these young people and sincere desire for peace despite the traumatic and shocking experiences of their childhood. The event concluded with a moving flag ceremony where representatives from 40 nations carried all 191 flags in a circle around the conference room. One by one the nation's names were called and everyone in the room

chanted the name in response, while sending peaceful thoughts to its people. Many of the second generation participants were grateful to be able to see the United Nations more closely. They could understand how the United Nations was an institute designed to realize world peace. However, they also noted that during the dialogue and discussion amongst the stu-



dents there were no solid conclusions reached. Everyone asked questions, but no one seemed to have concrete answers. More so, everyone seemed to have different ideas about what 'peace' actually consists of. In this way we also saw a need for the United Nations to be renewed. It was an informative experience for all. ❖

It is amazing. There is no barrier, no day time, no night time, no particular division in him. That means he calls any time, 3 a.m., 2 a.m., and God right away talks to him. Recently I bought a small recording machine because I have to be ready any time. Yesterday during Hoon Dok Hae while reading the book I suddenly felt I was standing right beside Father. Father's spirit came and immediately I felt the embodiment of God and started talking. I feel sorry to American members that you can't get direct word from Father because you have to hear a translation. It's valuable, but still not enough. This is a crucial and precious age and time.

All these pioneers went first. We don't exactly know the reason, but each one of these brothers and sisters are connected to God's providence and each one of them went as a living offering. They never die but live in lasting love and peace. Indeed, they are living in spirit world. These two worlds are coming closer and closer.

Recently many Korean members whose spouses ascended are communicating directly with them, living together. I've been hearing beautiful stories. And not only that, Father blessed some of our senior sisters with saints who lived thousands of years ago. Amazing story. Spirit world is so nearby.

A 430 couple brother had passed away, Mr. Yu, worked in our headquarters foundation in finance and property management. He and his wife have five daughters, and every Sunday at 4 o'clock he comes down to wake them up one by one to prepare to do kyung beh. He was worried because his wife was weak. He appeared to one of our brothers who is a realtor and asked, why don't you guide my wife to sell our house and move somewhere else. Even in spiritual world he is managing finances!

Very detailed. It is real. Still the wife felt lonely and sometimes sorrowful. When she missed her husband, she'd drive to the won jeon. One day he strongly scolded her, don't come.

One day Father called all those widows and asked for their testimonies. It was amazing. Everybody had a great testimony. I know that sister pretty well because she lives near HQ church. Now she is running a business there, a gift shop. When I saw her she was always bright and I wondered how she could be so happy since she lost her husband. I felt a little uncomfortable, because I knew her husband very well. Later I heard from her that her husband comes to her every night, guiding, talking. Not only to her, but he also visits their children. I think this kind of story will eventually become very common. The two worlds are becoming one.

Dear American family, you might miss your spouse or child who has gone to the spiritual world, but their point of view is different. We have to catch their spirit. They are pretty busy. Recently the only son of the continental director of the Middle East, Rev. Ji, passed away in Jardim, at age 17. Father loved him because he fished a lot nearby there. He is actually buried in the Jardim area. Father blessed him to go to Heung Jin Nim. But his mother missed him because he was her only son. When we had the registration blessing in Cheong Pyeong, suddenly he came to his mother in her dream and said, mom, I'm an assistant to Heung Jin Nim. She saw Heung Jin Nim coming in and his assistants were all 2nd gen. She saw her son was toward the front. After that she completely released the sorrow in her heart. I was there when Rev. Ji reported these things to Father.

I'm sure these great brothers and sisters are working hard and doing great work in spirit world. Don't worry about them. Instead let's be focused on what we are doing in our own lives. Many of our brothers and sisters want to come here, so we are going to make a very strict policy. The price may go up! Some day \$20,000 a slot! That much I think people will be honored to be here. ❖

Chicago Pastors' Prayer Breakfast

son was deeply moved. He has overseen the transition of the city of Pat- terson from a primarily Italian community to a mixed international community with the largest Arab/ Muslim community in America.

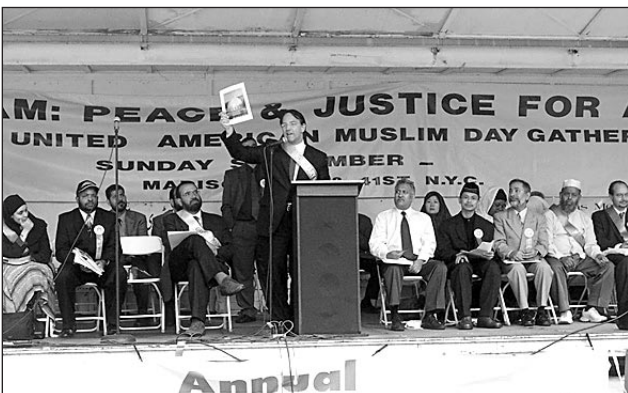
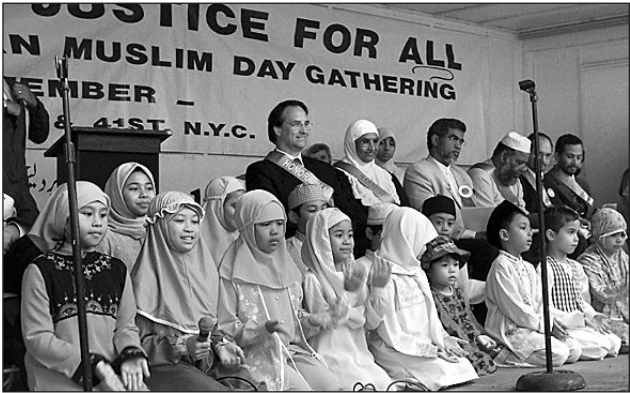

Saturday, October 11, a great victory for world peace under one God and a new start for 52 newly appointed Ambassadors of Peace took place at the Downey Community Center from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm. After a dynamic performance of the Unity Singers', "Unity in the Community" song, the MC, Councilman Keith McCarthy of Downey delivered his welcoming remarks and Rev. Brown of Pasadena gave a heartfelt invocation. The event was well attended. 124 Ambassadors for Peace and guests and 67 members participated, but several members of those "members" who are lawyers, bank managers or a city council member already have joined the ranks of Ambassadors for Peace. The audience included many Christian clergy, but also Moslems, Hindus, Buddhists, and many leaders in education, business, media, finance, sports, and representatives of NGO's including the United Nations Association.

Mr. Antonio Betancourt, the Secretary General of the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace spoke on the mission of the Ambassadors for Peace. He challenged all present to go the way of Peace unaccomplished in Adam's time and through all of history. The way pioneered by the True Parents, he said, is the true and ultimate solution to human conflict. Each couple, he emphasized, must study the Divine Principle and follow the model course of the True Parents. His very direct message was well received and the full-spectrum of IIFWP activities was covered in a 17-minute overview video which was presented directly following his presentation. Each participant received a packet at the registration desk containing "The Seeds of True Peace:

The Fruits of True Love", a CD overview of IIFWP and True Parents' Ministry and also a copy of the book World Lead-

ers Speak: The Messiah Has Come, and the Founder's Address at the Inaugural Assembly of the Interreligious and International Peace Council, as well as an invitation and registration form for the third Pilgrimage to the Holy Land and a response form questionnaire.

Imam Haitham Bundakji, the President of the Islamic Society of Orange County testified about the tremendous power for peace of nearly five-hundred clergy including the three abramic faiths and several other religions. He spoke with great enthusiasm that this is the only way to realize peace; that Rev. Moon is the only one bringing this level of unity between the divided peoples of many religious views.

Mr. Andrew Weis shared a warm and wonderful testimony of his experience at the interfaith conference in Jerusalem. He told of triumph over concepts first around the table and later at his own family meetings here in California. The testimonies were echoed in a five minute video entitled "Peace Under One God: Pilgrimage for Reconciliation". Rev. Manly of San Diego spoke strongly about the UN demonstration and the Inaugural Assembly of the Interreligious International Peace Council. He pointed out that Jesus calls us to demonstrate his standard of love for others. Ms. Norma Foster, President of the Pacific-Los Angeles Chapter of the United Nations Association, shared her hope for peace through the unity of leaders of faith in actions for peace. The hope, she shared, is not in contemplation, but action.

The Conference proved to be a festival of song as well as soul-stirring testimony. Dr. James Gambrell, CEO of a production company and soloist for Mt. Zion Baptist, poured his heart into the lyrics of "To God Be the Glory" and received a standing ovation. Next, Ms. Blinky Williams, director of the Hollywood Choir, brought the crowd to their feet to sing "Let Their Be Peace on Earth"



as one huge chorus. This simple song had an amazing effect of raising the spirit through having everyone present in full participation. Then Rev. Godwin D'Silva, the IIFWP Co-convenor in Los Angeles read aloud a selection from the Founder's Address at the Inaugural Assembly of the Interreligious and International Council for Peace as each participant followed along in their own copy.

Next, new Ambassadors for Peace were appointed in groups of ten. Each time the certificates were presented by Mr. Antonio Betancourt and Bishop Baek Joong Ku to the new Ambassadors and a commemorative photo was taken. Fifty-two Ambassadors were appointed at that time, another nine high-level leaders will be appointed in smaller ceremonies in the greater Los Angeles area in the next two weeks.

The meeting came to a conclusion with a home-cooked luncheon. Fruit and vegetable plates were brought to the tables and a buffet sandwich line provided turkey and beef sandwiches on fresh baked French bread, a whole



variety of salads and potato-onion soup (a real crowd pleaser). Rev. Hart gave the blessing for the food and it was evident in his prayer that he was truly inspired. The Unity Singers and the Sadoc Christian Singers (pictured below) rocked the place during the luncheon. The spirit moved and dozens stood clapping a swaying to the sounds of the Sadoc Christian Singers.

Rev. Hart wrote in his reflection paper, "This has to be one of the greatest events in my life. I have a different opinion of unity now. Peace is greater than any of us. Thanks for the video presentation. We were able to see and hear from those who were seated at our tables. This was my first meeting [with IIFWP] and I was indeed impressed." ❖

‘Messiah’ by Bo Hi Pak

This two-volume biography of the Reverend Sun Myung Moon, originally written in Korean by his devoted disciple, Dr. Bo Hi Pak, and now available in English, has a value beyond being a testimony to nearly 60 years of Rev. Moon's public ministry. An accomplished writer, longtime career officer in the South Korean army, Pak was the Reverend Moon's chief agent in the founding of the Washington Times in 1982 as well as the director of myriad until-now unheralded projects which helped Ronald Reagan and other Cold-War conservatives toss the Evil Empire onto the ash heap of history.

Pak has played a significant role in the Reverend Moon's American enterprises since the mid-sixties, when he was sent here to establish the American Unification Church. In the seventies when his leader moved to the United States or began to spend considerable time and money here, Pak expanded his informational and organizational activities, becoming publisher of The News World daily in New York (in 1976) and founder of both the Unification Church-supervised World Media Association and a vehicle for academic outreach, CAUSA (in 1980). Such efforts helped create centers for the dissemination of views that were thematically connected to the Church's millenarian focus, the age of peace and spiritual unity that the Reverend Moon would usher in after the passing of a century of war.

In this cosmic scheme, Communism represented the last critical challenge to the rule of peace - a "satanic force," which would have enslaved humanity, had not divine Providence raised up the United States to oppose its ideas and political-military force. Pak reflects the Reverend Moon's view that United

States had a providential mission to be the world-historical player against Communism in the late twentieth century.

One need only add to this predestined confrontation between Good and Evil a Korean background to understand the per-

sonal mission of Pak and of the man he serves. The Reverend Moon and many of those around them came out of an already Christianized Asian culture, which served as a bridge to the Western world, albeit to an almost Victorian-looking Protestantism.

Original sin, divine redemption, and moral rectitude are all basic to the Unificationist religion, which also reflects a deeply personal experience, the trauma of Korean nationalists who, like the Reverend Moon, suffered grievously under the Communists. Out of this combination of what appears to be an adaptation of nineteenth-century Presbyterianism and the Korean anti-Communist experience came the plans to found the Washington Times Corporation and to promote the presidential ambitions of Governor Ronald Reagan.

Pak and the Reverend Moon had been eying Reagan as an American national leader from the mid-seventies on. What appealed to them about this figure was his unwavering anti-Communism; and in 1980, the Reverend Moon prodded The News World into announcing Reagan's electoral victory on its front cover before the returns were in. In a meeting shortly before the election with the then Repub-

lican presidential candidate, Pak addressed him as "President Reagan" and assured the gratified candidate that this was "a revelation from God received by the Reverend Sun Myung Moon." Such information casts light on the close relations between the Reverend Moon's publishing activities and the anti-Communist wing of the Republican Party.

For a Korean sponsor deeply concerned about world Communism, it seemed natural to concentrate his efforts on the one non-Communist superpower and to promote the electoral prospects of avowedly anti-Communist American politicians.

A final revelation for me in reading this biography was the willingness of the Washington Times benefactor to

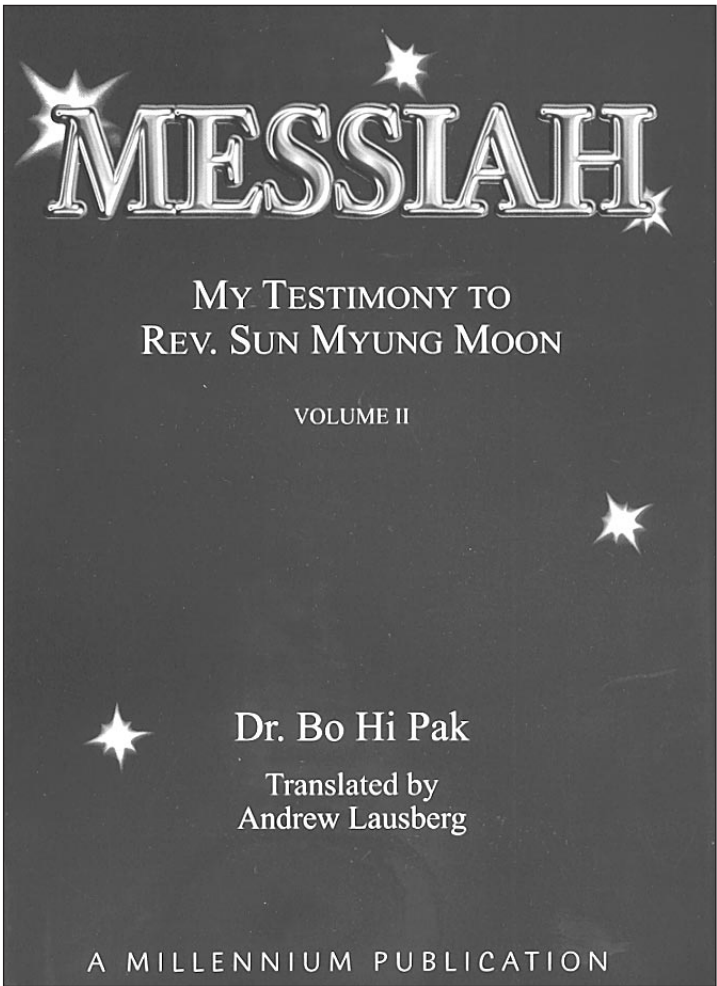
undergo what is called by Pak a "twentieth-century crucifixion." From July 1984 until August 1985, the Reverend Moon was in a federal penitentiary (and later a halfway house) supposedly for having defrauded the IRS of less than \$7,300. He was jailed on the kind of blown-up tax evasion charges that might have been used to run a leader of organized crime off the streets. And politicians, most vocally Bob Dole, stirred the pot while chasing after anti-Moonie voters.

The Reverend Moon could easily have left the country and returned to Korea, which may have been what his detractors wanted. Instead he stayed and went to jail, while blessing the country that sent him there. Pak may be correct to see this as a conscious imitation of Christ, particularly given the Unificationist view that the Founder is bringing about

the Second Advent and sees himself as completing Christ's mission. In any case, the biography does clarify its subject's almost joyous acceptance of an unjust punishment.

Pak's repeated contention that his subject is an "unsung hero of Soviet liberation" is axiomatic. The continued refusal of beltway conservatives to recognize this fact is, of course, scandalous.

Dr. Pak also gives an amazing behind-the-scenes account of Rev. Moon's meetings with Mikhail Gorbachev in Moscow in 1990 and Kim Il Sung of North Korea in 1991. How an avowed anti-communist would meet the leading communists of the day is truly an inspiring story.

The 2nd Fishing World Cup in Yeosu

Over 1000 anglers from 50 nations round the globe gathered in Nam-myeon and Samsan-myeon, a tourist city, notable of the marine leisure and sport culture, October 21th and 24th.

According to Mr. Shin, Wan-Soo, the President of Hanyeong Collage and the chairman of 'Yeosu City Fishing World Cup Induction Committee', it was agreed upon that the Fishing World Cup 2003, the celebration of 50 million fishing loving people of the world, be held in adjacent water of Nam-myeon and Samsan-myeon of Yeosu City, for a period of 5 days starting on the coming October 6th, and over 1000 anglers of 50 nations in the world are expected to

gather together. "Through this event, Yeosu City will become acknowledged in the world as a tourist cultural city of marine leisure and sport", the chairman Shin said.

In the 2nd Fishing World Cup, the anglers compete in one of two categories of 'Boat Fishing' and 'Surf Casting', and the first, second and the third winners will be awarded with \$20,000 (26 million won), \$15,000 (19.5 million won) and \$10,000 (13 million won) cash prize respectively.

According to the Tournament Rules, the



champions are determined by the total weight of girella (Benguetom porgy), snapper, and black porgy among other fishes which are common in the southern waters of Korea. Those who wish to take part in the tournament are requested to submit their photos and the application forms to the Induction Committee's head office. The secretary general of Yeosu Induction Committee, Mr. Kan, Ki-Bom said, "Our objective through this event is to place a local city on the global stage, and thus to create an opportunity that enables a local govern-

ment to expand the worldwide marketing activities. Also, he expressed a hope that a new sport culture rises in harmony with the natural environment.



West Block Leadership Seminar

September 8th through 11th the 2nd West Block Leadership Seminar, lead by Rev. Baek Joong Ku, was held at the Riviera Hotel in Las Vegas. The theme of the Conference was "Church Growth". The main topics were growth through Divine Principle education and growth through developing a dynamic worship service. Thirty-eight participants attended, including nine wives, 2 full days of seminar and a day of astounding sight-seeing at the Grand Canyon which provided much needed time for discussion and interaction during the drive there and back.

On the first day arrivals were scheduled for 4 p.m. and by 4:20 the seminar presentations were underway. Rev. Ku opened the event with a statement of purpose and introduced Rev. Henning's presentation of the Unification Worldview Class for Leaders of the Second Israel. A CD was distributed and the method of study and presentation explained together with the results of the sixteen week seminar thus far.

Then, Rev. Henning demonstrated the first half of the "Second Coming" presentation. Several leaders testified that they felt new confidence for teaching ministers and applying the scriptures to their explanation of Divine Principle. The next morning after Hoon Dok Hae with the former President's messages, read by Mr. James Oberg of Seattle, Rev. Thompson, Pastor of the Family Church in San Francisco delivered his PowerPoint presentation on "Communicating to Change Lives". His advice on preparation and delivery of sermon material was really helpful, stressing the relevance of the material to members' real situations and the prayer and effort that goes into a message that can win hearts and grow the church. Several State Leaders shared their reports

each morning giving an update on membership and the type of worship service and outreach activities they conduct.

The report on Oregon's activity was presented by Rev. John Dixon, that of Hawaii by Rev. Hu, Colorado by Rev. Nagalame, Nebraska by Rev. Kinami, Utah by Rev. Hwang, Arizona by Rev. Delgado and Idaho represented by Rev. David Coryell. City leader Rev. Joseph Carboneau added a special report on 2nd Generation fundraising for ACLC projects in Arizona. The third major topical presentation was delivered by Rev. Gerhard Wiesinger of Seattle, Washington. He spoke on "Society Outreach" showing victories in the media coverage and projects done with community cooperation to highlight the work of Rev. Yakawich in Montana as well as the Wiesingers' family foundation in Seattle. He called for Unificationists to "make a difference" in their local communities.

The next major topic was "Tithing Life" presented by Rev. Ku. His presentation was very frank, reviewing the real situation of our church and teaching that the real value of tithing lay not only in the financial foundation for the work of the church, but in that the act of tithing is a condition to protect members from Satan's invasion and help



them be spiritually healthy as well as materially blessed by God.

He reviewed ways to increase tithing in the churches and challenged leaders to teach their members by example, carefully offering all things properly. Rev. Matazaki made a point of tithing from the money he made "fundraising" in the casino, which Rev. Ku offered to the Idaho church, which has only three families to support it. Next Mr. Fujita shared about the video center witnessing program in Santa Monica, California. He has recently brought many new full-time members through the education series that are western. At one time people thought only Japanese students could join this way. After Mr. Fujita's points on witnessing, Rev. Ku spoke on "Dynamic

Worship" relating the ways he's changed the service in Los Angeles to be more effective. One of the most important witnessing venues is the Sunday morning experience in the sanctuary. New members should come from the powerful experience of God visitors experience in our worship service.

An overview of the goal and process of minister outreach witnessing was shared by Rev. Tengan from his experience in Los Angeles. He spoke of creating "Family Churches" by a formula course in education and attending events leading up to blessing the couple with holy wine and forty-days separation and three-day ceremony to change blood lineage. Ministers who understand True Father's position and mission could begin teaching in their churches, not only lectures but showing the pattern of blessed family life. These branch churches would be our hope to expand quickly and allow the ministers to fulfill a leadership role.

Rev. Matazaki's report on True Parents' Hawaii Providence and the Island Federation of Nations rounded the day out with stunning pictures of the natural beauty of Hawaii and close-up shots of the True Parents.

Wednesday was totally involved in Grand Canyon adventure and Thursday the conclusion was summed up by Rev. Ku after Hoon Dok Hae and state reports. The reflections written then were full of praise for the short conference and determinations to be more effective and bring about church growth.

Immediately afterwards, he announced, “by the end of May [1998], within 180 days, we have the goal of blessing 360 million couples.” Originally, he said, “the 36,000,000 Couples Blessings was to be held in May” but “Heaven was in such a rush that a waterfall came down.” Rev. Moon clearly understood that the present moment was fraught with possibilities. As he put it, “The spirit world became mobilized and pushed the physical world.” Theology and the sorting-out process could wait. The emphasis now was on achieving breakthroughs.

If Rev. Moon pushed theological categories to the breaking point, he also pushed members beyond their self-imposed limits. His criticism of American members for their tendency to specialize and focus on one task at a time was mentioned. He also was critical of what he regarded as Americans’ preference for professional management and rational planning techniques over reliance on the mysterious power of the spiritual world. The Harvard Business School approach was simply not the way he intended to run the movement. Too frequently, that style had collided with his response to immediate providential mandates. The blessing of 360 million couples before the year 2000 clearly was a providential mandate. Just as obviously, it would force members, once again, to break through their concepts of what was possible or permissible.

Ironically, members had just gotten comfortable with the measures pioneered for Blessing ’97. Now, in effect, they were put on notice that these methods were obsolete. There simply was not enough time for door-to-door, person-to-person Blessings in order to achieve the expected result. Blessing three, five or even eight couples an evening and, perhaps, double that on weekends was not sufficient. Beach Blessings and Blessing booths at county fairs might have put a dent in the totals. Unfortunately, the beaches were closed, and there would be no county fairs before May. In fact, major portions of the Northern hemisphere were wrapped in ice and snow, making any Blessing work difficult. At a February 3, 1998 International Leaders’ Meeting in Korea, Rev. Kwak reported that the Blessing Ceremony of 360 million couples would be held in twelve major cities around the world on June 13th. Sometime after that, it was decided that Blessing ’98 would be conducted for 120 million couples and that the remaining 240 million would be Blessed at a later unspecified date.

This was hardly a reprieve. The North American goal was still 10 million couples, an exponential leap from the 400,000 that Rev. Joong Hyun Pak reported North America had Blessed in 1997. Furthermore, it was decided that the main ceremony again would be in the United States. This came as a surprise. American members had expected that the next Blessing would be in Japan. In fact, a key point in obtaining the maximum exertion from tribal messiahs during the RFK campaign was the assurance given that this was the last Blessing True Parents would ever perform in America and, hence, the final opportunity for members to demonstrate their wholehearted support. The reason why Japan could not host the main ceremony was clear. As a result of his felony tax conviction, Rev. Moon was barred under Japanese law from entering the country. The reason why the United States was again chosen for the main ceremony was less clear. Some of the same reasoning as for Blessing ’97 undoubtedly applied. In particular, a U.S. venue offered the most substantial opportunity for global impact. According to Rev. Pak, America’s Christian base and the movement’s breakthroughs with Christian ministers, 2,000 of whom reportedly had been Blessed, were deci-

York was chosen. Once this was decided, there was a debate over the site. Some favored another stadium event; others pushed for a more intimate venue. In the end, Madison Square Garden was selected. It was famous and large enough to be acceptable. Although the rental and set-up costs would be substantial, it was simpler to work with than a stadium. There also was the possibility for more intimacy and control. In addition, there was the advantage of MSG being directly across from the 2,000 room, church-owned New Yorker Hotel and within blocks of HSA National Headquarters. Finally, there was a sense of connectedness to the movement’s tradition. Members liked to think in threes and Blessing ’98 would be the third major event the movement had sponsored at MSG. Rev. Moon’s 1974 Day of Hope speech on “The New Future of Christianity” was a formation-stage event. It overflowed the Garden and served as a coming-out occasion for the movement in America. The 2075 Couple Blessing in 1982 was a growth-stage event. It brought together members who had joined during the 1970s and pointed them in new directions through the 1980s and early 1990s. Blessing ’98 would be a perfection or completion stage event. Members hoped it would define the movement’s mature identity and role in the U.S. and elsewhere. However, Blessing ’98 was a far more concentrated campaign. There were two years to get ready for Blessing ’97. This allowed time for trial and error, the refinement of methods, the building of morale, the convening of a multifaceted WCSF, and the elaboration of complex mobilization strategies. This was not possible in the little more than six months between RFK and MSG. In fact, by the time major decisions were made, there were less than four months to prepare.

In an effort to come up with “ideas and guidelines” for Blessing ’98, Dr. Tyler Hendricks convened a “Brainstorming Session” for some seventy-five elders of the U.S. and Canadian movements at Unification Theological Seminary in February. The conference was carefully structured to include plenary meetings on Reflections From RFK and Evangelism and Marketing the Blessing followed by break-out sessions on Program Design; High Level Outreach; Financial Planning; Youth, Singles and Matching; Media Strategies, and Education of Blessed Couples. Bill Lay, who covered the conference for *Unification News*, noted that “many approaches to life and the UC were on display over the weekend.” Dan Fefferman, a respected elder member, commented that America’s goal of 40 million couples out of 360 million, “taken as a percentage of all married couples in America,” represented “a greater market share than that of Coca Cola.” He argued that this level of market share only gets achieved though a “serious commitment to mass marketing.” Others held that “there are no problems, we just need to buckle down and believe” or that the only real problem was that members were “all so distant from the level of [Rev. Moon].”

The Barrytown conclave was purely advisory and had

sive. On the other hand, North America’s Blessing ’97 total of 400,000 was only one percent of the 40,000,000 reported worldwide.

Although the U.S. was given responsibility to host Blessing ’98, the specific city was not yet clear. Some east-coast members hoped that Chicago or Los Angeles would be given the honor. However, this was not to be, and New

only a limited effect upon pre-Blessing activity. As during the RFK campaign, tribal messiahs and members were thrown back upon their own resources. Reports of pre-Blessing totals were taken at face value with no questions asked and no attempt to verify results. Objective pre-Blessing norms and guidelines increasingly gave way to subjective ones. Previously, the injection of holy wine, recitation of vows, the sprinkling of holy water, a forgiveness ceremony, a completed FFWPU form, and in most cases a photograph were required. All of this might have taken only a few minutes, but each element was regarded as essential to a bona fide pre-Blessing. Now, pre-Blessings seemingly could take a variety of forms so long as members maintained a proper attitude. All night song, testimony and prayer meetings were common in areas dedicated to reaching the highest pre-Blessing totals.

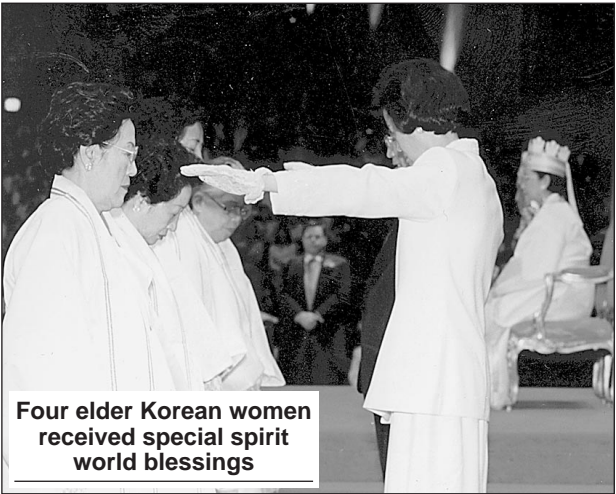
If the movement was *laissez faire* as to pre-Blessing activity, it was hands-on and well organized in its effort to fill Madison Square Garden. It also adopted a different approach. Essentially, the movement pulled back from the cultural dimension of previous World Culture and Sports Festivals. There was a three-day Special Convocation on “The Family and World Peace.” The nine co-sponsoring organizations united their previously separated conferences into a single meeting. The focus was on the Blessing ceremony itself.

While the short turnaround between the two events and the character of New York were important, the major reason why the movement soft-pedaled the WCSF was because it focussed its effort on religious contacts. In doing so, the movement developed a number of specific strategies. Early in the mobilization effort, it set up an Ecumenical Action Office directed by Rev. Ki Hun Kim from Chicago. Rev. Kim set a goal of mobilizing 10,000 people from Christian churches for Blessing ’98. A key strategy of this office was the convening of Blessing ’98 Meetings and Banquets in each New York City district as well as New Jersey and Philadelphia. These

were intended to re-connect ministers from past campaigns to tribal messiahs and District leaders. A second strategy was the convening of a “Pro-Family Rally” at MSG with “Blessing ’98 Family Awards” given immediately prior to the start of the Blessing ceremony. A third strategic step was the creation of a massive 2,000-voice choir from 77 churches. Finally, the movement subsidized the cost of chartered buses for congregations and flew in ministers from distant locations.

These strategies were hugely successful. The clearest indication of this was the packed arena. An estimated 20,000 people turned out. In fact, the doors closed more than an hour before the start of the Blessing event. Rev. Kim noted, “Over 200 churches brought their congregations.” Over 120 ministers and 14 buses of parishioners came from Chicago alone. The Pro-Family Rally was highly successful in helping insure an early turnout and an appropriate focus in the pre-ceremony proceedings. It also demonstrated the movement’s connections within the religious community.

Rev. Dennis Dillon, publisher of the *New York Christian Times*, served as emcee; a Hispanic pastor offered the invocation; a white Pentecostal Philadelphia evangelist was the first speaker; a diverse mix of twenty or so ministers received Blessing ’98 Family Awards for demonstrating outstanding leadership in their churches and communities; PBS film critic Michael Medved and his wife Diane delivered a video message of support and

appreciation over the jumbotrons; the 2,000-voice choir electrified the audience with spirited renditions of “Kumbaya” and an original piece entitled, appropriately enough, “Blessings”; and Rev. Wyatt Tee Walker, senior pastor of the Canaan Baptist Church of Christ in Harlem and Chairman of the Board of the National Action Network, delivered the keynote address.

Blessing organizers were thrilled by the response. Although recently matched member couples still were arrayed in neat rows on the floor and the Pro-Family Rally was distinct from the Blessing ceremony, there was more of a unified thrust. Part of this was due to the 2,000-voice choir which filled the hall with its massed voices during “Amazing Grace” and the “Hallelujah Chorus.” There also was the opportunity for more milieu control and intimacy. At precisely 11:00 a.m., the satellite hookup was established and a highly polished “Welcome to New York City” video clip began on huge jumbotrons. The hall lights similarly dimmed for video introductions preceding benedictions by representatives of eight world religions. Unlike in Washington D.C., there were few, if any negative newspaper articles in the days preceding the Blessing or afterwards. Even the NYPD expressed appreciation for the movement’s “good organization in unloading and loading 520 buses.”

Amid all the good feeling, there were a couple of dissonant notes. One of these was the tendency to highlight distinctions between godly and ungodly forces in society. This was especially apparent in the Pro-Family Rally. It was also evident in depictions of Madison Square Garden as an “ark of salvation” within a largely reprobate city. The fact that there was a torrential downpour and savage thunderstorm going on outside during the event accentuated participants’ sense of being among the elect. Rev. Joong Hyun Pak credited “God with the weather” and cited someone who said, “Inside MSG was Noah’s Ark, outside was judgment!”

However, it was Dr. Tyler Hendricks, President of the Unification Church in America, who worked the ark imagery into an extended reflection and who drew the clearest, or at least the most stark distinction between those who responded and didn’t respond to Blessing ’98. In a section entitled “Where Were You on June 13?” within his regular “UViews” monthly column, he criticized New York Mayor Rudy Giuliani and the Dalai Lama, both of whom were invited but declined due to schedule conflicts, the mayor to join a gay pride parade in Brooklyn, the Dalai Lama to preside over a two-day Tibetan benefit rock concert, ironically enough, at RFK Stadium, Washington, D.C.

According to Dr. Hendricks, “A religious leader chose an event on behalf of his nation instead of one on behalf of the world. A political leader chose an event on behalf of homosexuality instead of one on behalf of godly marriage.” Utilizing the “ark of salvation” metaphor to evaluate the contrasting outcomes, he wrote, “We could consider Madison Square Garden on June 13 as a place of salvation, like the ark. Those who heard the call came inside. The weather was fine as we entered. The doors were closed, courtesy of the Madison Square Garden staff. Outside were the gay pride activists, the anti-Moon demonstrators, the Hollywood rock concert for Tibet. When the doors closed, when the Blessing started, the rains came. Torrential rains washed out the gay pride parade. The rains wiped out the anti-Moon protesters. Lightning struck RFK Stadium, seriously injuring eleven people. All these events were called off. Inside the Garden, no one was in the least bit aware of the weather raging outside. And when we emerged, when the doors opened, the rain had stopped. We walked out onto literal dry ground. The air smelled fresh; something was washed.”

A delicious irony, of course, was that many of those drenched on the outside, with the possible exception of the gay pride activists and anti-Moon demonstrators, were in all likelihood either knowingly or unknowingly blessed!

The introduction of spirit world Blessings at Blessing ’98 was a second discordant note. This was quite unexpected. It already was a stretch for more than a few ministers and their congregations to countenance Hindu, Buddhist, Sikh and Muslim benedictions over the proceedings. The thought that billions of spirit world couples, including a select group of religious founders and some of the worst criminals of history, were also participating in the Madison Square Garden event surely would have been either incomprehensible or unacceptable for most. Nevertheless, the first order of business once Rev. and Mrs. Moon, as officiators, had taken their seats was a “Report to Heaven” delivered by Rev. Chung Hwan Kwak. Rev. Kwak reported that True Parents were tearing down all the existing walls in the spiritual world, including the wall of hell.

He announced that on this occasion, they were extending the pre-Blessing to “16 billion couples in the spiritual world.” He stated, “This may sound unbelievable, but it is true.” He announced, “Included in the Blessing of numerous spirits are 34 couples who will receive a special Blessing as the representatives both from God’s side and from Satan’s side. These include: Jesus, Con-

the union of Heung Jin and Julia Moon. Even earlier, on January 3, 1971, Rev. Moon was understood to have blessed Jesus with a Korean church member. At Blessing ’98, immediately following his “Report to Heaven,” Rev. and Mrs. Kwak, presumably with Heung Jin and Jesus, presided over a “physical and spiritual world ceremony” in which “four Korean women elders were...Blessed as wives on earth to four major saints of the spirit world—Buddha, Confucius, Mohammed, and Socrates.”

A second reason why the introduction of spirit world Blessings might not be considered a retreat had to do with the logic of the Blessing and the movement’s teachings. As Rev. Kwak indicated, there was no corner of reality that the Blessing of true love could not penetrate. Spirit world Blessings were a logical extension of this principle. Further, if Rev. and Mrs. Moon’s status as True Parents and their declaration of messiahship were to be taken seriously, they ought to be lords of heaven as well as earth. In an editor’s note accompanying its coverage of Blessing ’98, the Unification News held that “Unificationist ideology is firmly planted on earth” but also took the spirit world “very seriously.” It cited a passage from The Exposition of the Divine Principle which stated, “Dur-



fucius, Buddha, Mohammed, Mary, Adam, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Joshua, Caleb, John the Baptist, Socrates, Swedenborg, Sundar Singh, Syn-gman Rhee, Hwal Ahn Kim, Park Chung Hee, Dwight D. Eisenhower, Richard Nixon, Nobusuke Kishi, Takeo Fukuda, Karl Marx, Vladimir Lenin, Joseph Stalin, Mao Tse Tung, Kim Il Sung, Adolph Hitler, Hideki Tojo, and Benito Mussolini.”

Rev. Kwak commented, “There is no corner that the Blessing of true love cannot reach.” It was “an amazing grace, not just for good spirits but for bad spirits as well, since it opens even the door to hell.” He asserted that through “this historic Blessing ceremony of the spiritual world and the earthly world, officiated by True Parents, all religious spheres can be harmonized to form a unified realm of blessing” and that the two worlds, spiritual and physical, “can unite into one, thus establishing the realm of liberation.” He concluded by proclaiming “this is the great, pivotal Blessing ceremony that will launch the era of Heaven on earth and in heaven centered on God and True Parents.”

There were several ways to interpret these extraordinary claims. They could be judged to be evidence of a retreat from engagement with the world, not into self-righteous sectarianism, but toward an otherworldly mysticism. At the same time, there were good reasons for maintaining that this was not the case. First, as has already been noted, spiritualism was an integral part of the movement’s tradition and had not interfered with its engagement with the world. Spirit world Blessings also were not unprecedented. A day prior to the 360,000 Couple Blessing in 1995, Rev. and Mrs. Moon blessed Mrs. Moon’s physical mother, Rev. Moon’s physical elder brother, and Rev. Moon’s physical mother, each of whom had passed from the physical plane. Blessings in which one partner was in the spirit world and the other on earth also had occurred. Previously, reference was made to

ing the period when the providence of restoration is to be completed after the Second Coming of Christ, God will complete the cosmic foundation for the Messiah by working throughout heaven and earth based on the Completed Testament Word.”

According to Richard Lewis, *Unification News* editor, this indicated that “from the 1950s, it was clear that Reverend Moon’s work would ultimately relate directly to the spirit world. Therefore, what is taking place now should come as no surprise.”

The public acknowledgement of spirit world Blessings was really more of a risk than a retreat. Had the movement acknowledged them only among its membership as a form of compensation or consolation for the lack of external results, the retreat label might have applied. However, Rev. Moon was springing mass spirit world Blessings on an unsuspecting public in much the same way as he sprung his declaration of messiahship on unsuspecting guests in 1992. This, in fact, was typical of his approach. Though members may have settled, or wished to settle into stable routines, he quite literally was living in apocalyptic time. At the very moment the movement had achieved a certain comfort level with its minister and parishioner guests, he introduced content sure to upset or even scandalize. For many, the spirit world announcement was unclear. Rev. Kwak read from a prepared text at a side microphone in soft tones with a Korean accent. The report itself was elaborate and dense, probably more suited for a gathering of academics than a mass audience whose senses had just been overwhelmed by a 2,000-voice choir and distracted by the spectacle of a lavishly decorated and packed arena. Most heard something about a Blessing of saints; and the names Stalin or Marx may have struck a dissonant chord for those listening carefully. However, there was no context for the report to have much of an effect, and explanations would have to wait for later. ❖

Father wrote a calligraphy for Mrs. Matsumoto.



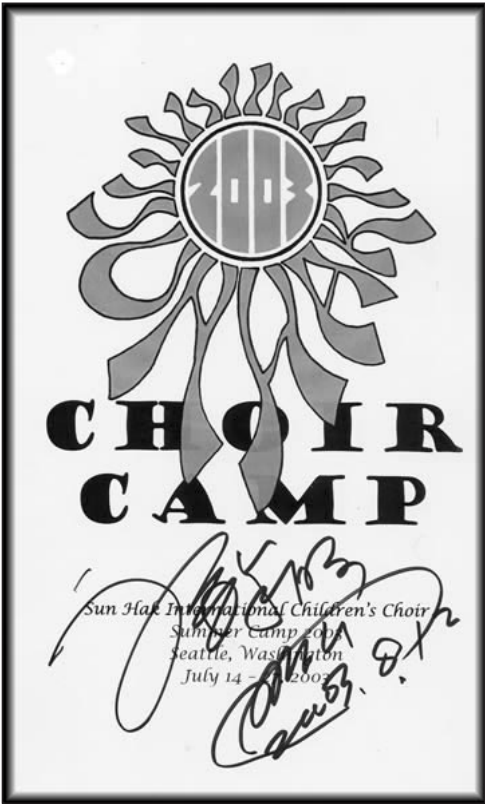
The Sun Hak International Children's Choir

Finding the Word

This is the first in a three part series about the Word of God. We won't focus on prophets and pastors, those anointed to bring God's Word to humanity. Rather, we'll look at people who are affected by their ministries.

Many people do their best to live by the Word. They are known, most simply, as believers. Some people spend their lives theorizing about holy words. These scholars are called theologians.

A few people study remnants of the past, including evidence for the Scriptures, and the actual lives of religious founders. These scientists are known as archaeologists, and this month we'll talk about them.

Discoverers

The major world religions were founded a long time ago. No videotapes of Jesus or Mohammed exist. Some religions even predate writing, so they have no original records at all. Thus, scholars must literally dig for evidence of those lives and times.

In olden days, natural erosion would sometimes reveal the bones of dinosaurs and other unfamiliar creatures. Folks naturally decided these must be the remains of mythic creatures, perhaps a monster slain by Hercules or another hero.

One scientist has shown that a 'sea monster' depicted on ancient Greek pottery is a dead ringer (no pun intended) for a known, seagoing dinosaur. It's not just dinosaurs, either. Arranged differently, the bones from a woolly mammoth look very much like a giant, hulking person.

With the rise of modern science people understood how old the Earth really is, and about the extinct creatures those bones represented. (How modern species arose is another debate entirely.)

Throughout most of history, people showed no interest in the ruins of earlier cities. (Called a 'tel' in the Middle East, they're all over the place. Natural hills have a different name.) Some old sites were quarried for their dressed stones, or looted in hopes of finding buried treasure, but that was all.

A few classical scholars, such as Herodotus (a Greek), and Ibn Battutah (an Arab), showed genuine interest in the past. They traveled far, listening to stories, keeping records, and collecting artifacts.

German businessman Heinrich Schliemann is recognized as the first modern archaeologist. Driven by an obsession with the Homeric epics (plus a dash of greed and showmanship), he determined to locate the lost city of Troy.

That famous city had been regarded as mere legend, but he stunned the world by actually finding it, in what is now Turkey. His methods were crude: he gouged a huge trench straight through the ruins, discarded all but the finest artifacts, then jumbled those together regardless of their

area of discovery.

Modern archaeologists dig slowly, with in marked grids, keeping every piece of bone, pottery, and other evidence. Chemical and DNA residue is analyzed, revealing clues about ancient climate and diets.

Patient and careful as they are, archaeologists are human, too. There are tenacious factions within archaeology, and fierce personal rivalries. Some people are biblical literalists, others are skeptics, and pretty much everyone has an agenda. Their disagreements encompass theories about the ancient word, but also some very modern politics and policies.

Two of their largest associations are forever at odds. The pages of Biblical Archaeology Review and Archaeology magazine are filled with debate. The former supports amateur diggers, and a limited market for common antiquities. The latter is dead-set

wealth of context and information. The types of implements used, the price of food and slaves, and descriptions of neighboring peoples, have all proven accurate.

Many inscriptions in Egypt and Babylon refer to the Jews, and name several Biblical personages. The Dead Sea Scrolls validated the age and accuracy of the Old Testament.

Recently, an ossuary (bone interment box) with a startling inscription was found. It reads: James, son of Joseph, brother of Jesus. Given the population of Jerusalem back then, and the occurrence of those specific names, it's quite likely direct evidence of St. James, the physical brother of Jesus!

However, because it wasn't revealed in situ, and as there are so many forgeries extant, it remains very controversial.

Another ossuary, almost as portentous,

Matching the Bible's timeline to science's can be a fascinating exercise. It seems to have a logarithmic relationship to the one put forth by archaeologists.

The time of Solomon and David is well known, and both accounts match in almost every respect. Before that, the dates diverge, crediting more, then much less, time since events actually occurred.

The Exodus probably took place closer to 1250 BC (rather than 1600 BC). Noah's Flood, if the Black Sea flooding theory is correct, happened around 7000 BC.

Adam and Eve certainly lived more than 130,000 years ago, and perhaps twice that long. Bones from physically modern humans were just found in Ethiopia, dating from 160,000 BC. (Please note that a small band of full-fledged, 'original' humans would have left few, if any, remaining signs.)

In regard to Eden and the Fall, Rev. Moon has spoken in terms of millions of years! Given the notorious difficulty of translating the Orient's 'san' and 'man' numbers into English (and my own deficiency in spoken Korean), plus all the deep symbolism involved, I cannot be certain of his meaning.

What surprises has modern archaeology brought us?

It seems that very ancient societies were somewhat democratic, with a clear division of political and religious leadership. (The Chieftain and the Shaman, respectively.)

The current theory is that, with the founding of cities and their ornate temples, pagan priests gained in power. In response, the secular rulers made themselves into Pharaohs or God-Kings.

To solidify their power, some rulers declared themselves champions of all their subjects, and began to institute specific rights and freedoms. For example, the Code of Hammurabi, which predates the Ten Commandments by centuries.

We moderns apparently gained more from the Fertile Crescent than we did from Egypt. Such as: a Sunday rest, and a religion featuring consubstantiation and a Trinity. But, as Goddess worshippers will tell you with a nyah-nyah-nyah, with a Mother instead!

Pagan apologists claim this belief was the ancestor of Christianity, and even that from which Jesus 'ripped off' his ideas. Rather, I would say, it was an early (and somewhat distorted) manifestation of the eternal Principled ideal.

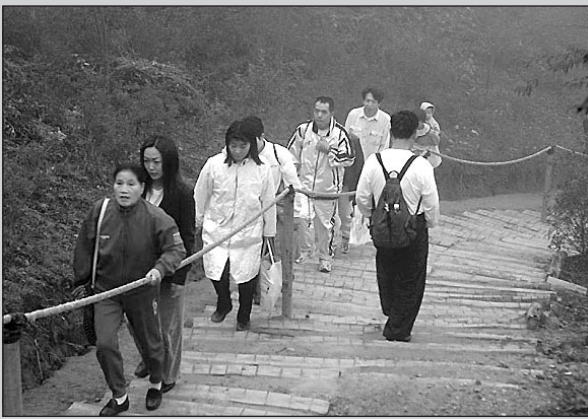
An informed, open minded person can no longer doubt that the Bible, and many other sacred books, are genuine historical documents.

Some scriptures are very old and largely symbolic, while others are quite accurate in their portrayal of the ancient world.

Therefore, the God to which the Bible refers to cannot be denied on its account. Quite the opposite: the story of its people, and even of the document itself, contains powerful evidence of God's hand. Furthermore, the Parallels of History reveal a clear pattern. Through it all, God remains sovereign.

against these. Like Indiana Jones, their cry is, "It belongs in a museum!" (Even if it's going to be stashed in some backroom storage crate.)

They've all decried the tragedy of looted museums in Iraq and elsewhere. Even then, their ideas on how to prevent future such looting differ sharply.

Validation

Archaeology encompasses the entire planet, but takes on a special meaning when focused on the Middle East.

Christians place tremendous importance on validating the Bible. Many people want to dismiss that book as myth, and self-serving propaganda, thus to slander its adherents.

Atheists go so far as to call it sheer fantasy, but ongoing discoveries won't let them get away with it!

Seemingly mundane details (especially from the Bible's oldest books) contain a

was excavated by a reputable archaeologist. The inscription shows it likely belonged to the family of Simon of Cyrene, bearer of Jesus' cross.

Implications

The Biblical timeline remains a subject of vigorous debate. Some key dates are fixed by Egyptian and other records, while others have been 'placed' all over the centuries. Central events such as the flight from Egypt are said to have taken place over a range of almost 500 years either way—if at all.

Our Principle contains a fascinating Parallels of History section. The latest translation acknowledges that it follows a literal Biblical timeline, rather than a scientific one. Few modern scholars, including most Christians, think the universe was created in the year 4004 BC. (Even 'young earth' Creationists have fudged the date to perhaps 8000 BC.)

Snapping Turtle Hunter



It's springtime and I don't know why, but wherever I'm driving I see turtles about to set foot into the death trap of oncoming traffic. Maybe they want to bask in the sun on the nice, hot pavement. They have no idea that they're about to become a stain if they don't move.

I find that I'm constantly scanning the roads, searching for turtles. I pass fields of wheat, alfalfa and foot-high corn. Tiny, gorgeous bluebirds flash in and out of the tall grass. The goldfinches are almost as plentiful, and the cardinals appear like red peppers against the green. As the birds dart through the pattern of sunlight and trees, I watch for the unmistakable army helmet shape of turtles at the road's edge.

A couple of weeks ago I saved one the size of a half a cantaloupe. He was brown and handsome, a box turtle — a LAND turtle — so it was a good thing I didn't deliver him into a pond. My kids told me about the Gary Larsson book, "There's a Hair in My Dirt" in which the heroine kindly (she thinks) throws a land turtle into the lake and it cries out, "Oh, the irony, the irony!" as it sinks to its death.

This week I found several real, pretty painted turtles, eager fellas, who did not want to be in the cardboard box on my backseat while I searched for a safe place to let them go.

I was driving down a major Virginia highway the other day — this was a full fledged, four lane country highway, not an Interstate, but a road with a 55 mph speed limit. I saw a large steering wheel sized thing in the road in the left lane

as I was going down the right lane and it turned out to be a big turtle. I pulled over on the shoulder and waited for the traffic to pass. A couple of people passed right over it. It pulled itself inside its shell and I shuddered for its life.

When the traffic dissipated I went up to it and saw a ridged back, and a long ridged tail. I went behind it and tried to pick it up by the back of the shell so I could move it out of the road. It lunged at me, hissing. Of course I dropped it like a hot potato. It was a snapping turtle - the first one I'd ever seen. It clearly did not appreciate the fact that I was trying to save its life. In fact, it thought of me as an enemy. Imagine! I was astounded by the involuntary pumping of my adrenaline. The traffic was backing up now. A well-meaning guy stopped in the LEFT LANE to help me and traffic backed up for half a mile.

"Here turtle, here turtle," I called tentatively. I tried to do the Dana Carvey "Master of Disguise" imitation. "Am I turtley enough for you?" He hissed and lunged.

Embarrassed by the situation and not knowing how to deal with it I decided to drive away. I was ashamed at my fear, at my lack of ingenuity. What would Steve Irwin, aka, the Crocodile Hunter, have done? He would've grabbed that baby and said, "What a beauty!" and would have moved it across the road before it knew what happened. And it would have paddled happily away into the deep, reedy river.

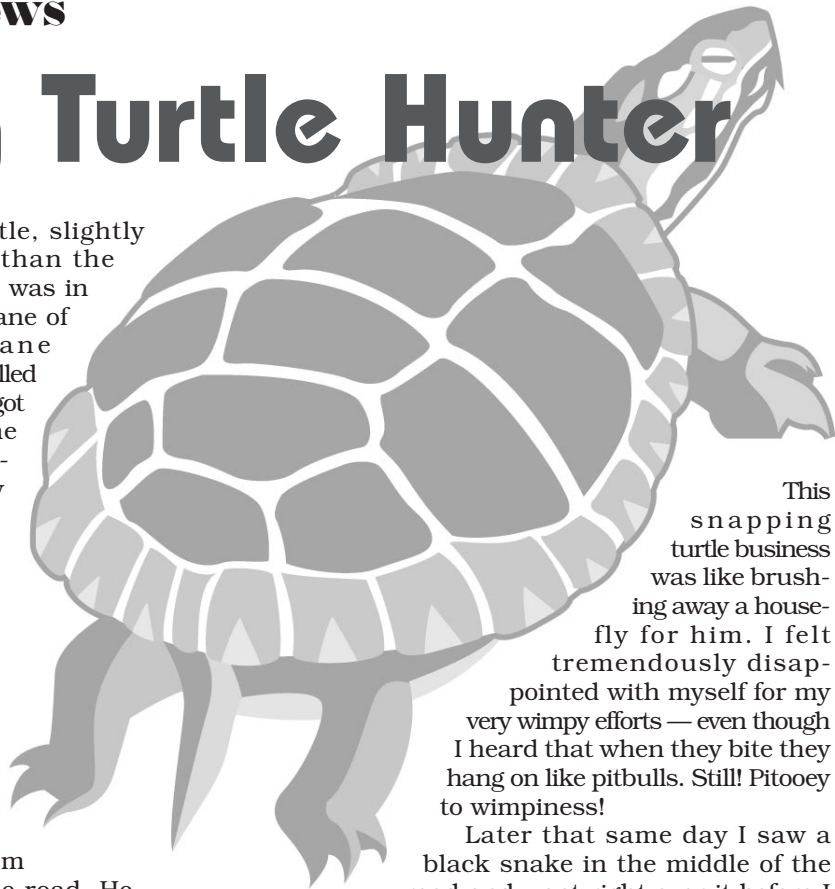
Even though I was as pumped as if I had just been mugged, I was ashamed of myself. I thought of the poor, huge, ill placed creature and wondered if it would get smashed to smithereens by a truck, or worse — tortured by a car load of dim-brained, young males.

When we drove past the spot on the way back he was gone, so I don't know what happened to him. But! Two days later I got my chance to try again!

My daughter, Gracie, and I were on a back road and another snap-

ping turtle, slightly smaller than the first one, was in the left lane of a two lane road. I pulled over and got out of the car thinking I knew what to do this time. I got out the jumper cables and with Gracie's help, tried to drag him out of the road. He turned and hissed and lunged at me. I got out a short shovel which I carry in the van, and found a stick and tried again. This turtle hated my guts too, just as much as the first snapping turtle I had met. Rejection in the line of love! Really, it was too much. I was full of all that nasty adrenaline again, and wasn't succeeding a second time. What should we do, Gracie, what should we do?

You know what I did? I gave up and drove away. I prayed for the angels of turtles to lead him home. I looked through the rear view mirror and he was heading back into the pond from whence he came. I was still kind of mad at myself for giving up a second time, I knew Steve Irwin wouldn't have given up. I had renewed respect for Steve. This guy climbs on the backs of crocodiles and picks up poisonous snakes.



This snapping turtle business was like brushing away a housefly for him. I felt tremendously disappointed with myself for my very wimpy efforts — even though I heard that when they bite they hang on like pitbulls. Still! Pitooey to wimpiness!

Later that same day I saw a black snake in the middle of the road and went right over it before I realized what it was. I mean, the tires went around it, but I didn't stop in time. When I returned from the other direction, the poor thing was smushed by someone else. I didn't move it in time!

I learned that no matter how much you care, you have to act! You can't always save everything, but it's worth it to seize the moment and try. Creation is too precious to let it go to waste. Krikey! 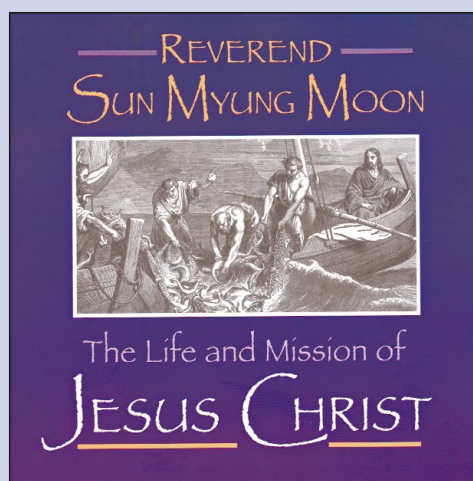
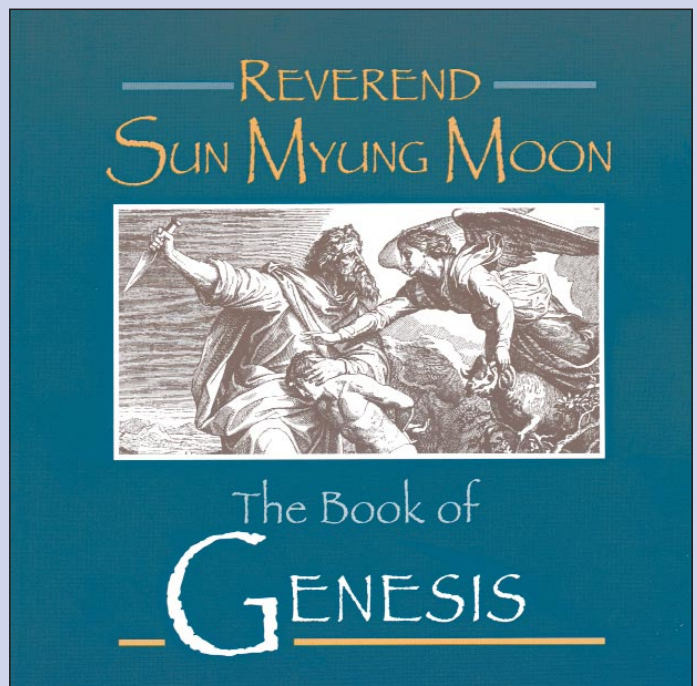
